

HOUSE WARMING AT COUNTRY CLUB

New Grounds May Be Christened Prior to Fall Live-stock Exhibit.

An important meeting of the Country Club and Livestock association will be held at headquarters, in the Hamilton building, next Monday at 4 p. m. Among other matters that will be taken up will be the reports of the contractors who are now at work grading the one-mile track at the Country club site, the contracts for the surfacing and finishing of the speedway, the work on the racing stables and the livestock show barns, all of which are well under construction.

The meeting next Monday afternoon will also decide whether there is to be a preliminary "house-warming," with a fireworks display, brass band, kite flying, airship, and other things, at any time previous to the opening of the meet, the last week of September.

World-be concessionaires have already approached the Country club people with propositions to give daily exhibition flights with an airship, and others have made overtures with a view of bringing to Portland the great chariot races from the New York hippodrome. They are contests that have never been seen in the Pacific northwest, but have proven the strongest kind of attraction in the east.

Next Monday afternoon's meeting will also decide whether there is to be an industrial exhibit and a poultry show in connection with the first annual session of the Pacific national meet to be held here.

The matter of holding an industrial and agricultural implement show in connection with the exposition here has already been taken up with the foremost dealers in the northwest, while chicken fanciers laid their claims before the executive committee of the Country Club and Livestock association some time ago.

While the men behind the Pacific national are very desirous to include in the week's program every feature that might be likely to prove a drawing card, a majority of the association seems to be convinced that it would be undertaking altogether too much to include a poultry show such as has been given in Portland for many successive years past, as well as an industrial exhibit.

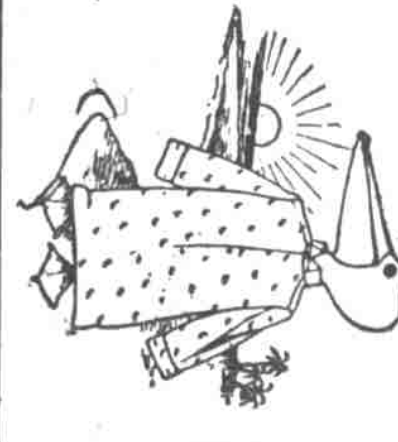

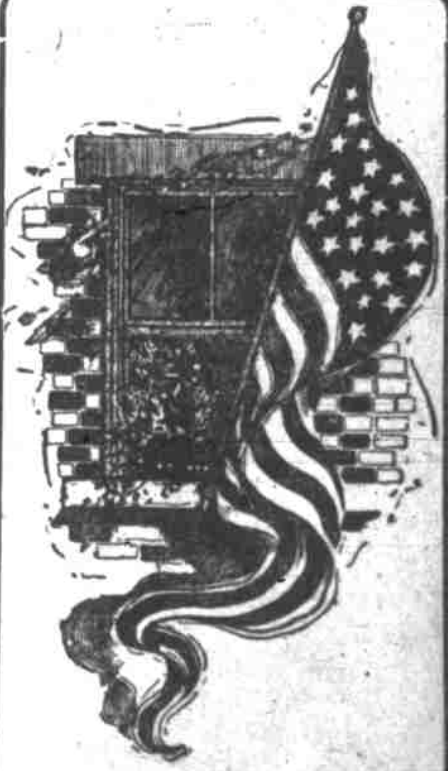
