CARRY LUMBER TO CHINESE PORT Oregon Pine Export Lumber Closes Large Deal Calling for Delivery of 7,000,000 Feet of Lumber at Shanghai Within a Few Weeks.

The Oregon Pine Export Lumber company chartered two "Strath" liners to carry lumber from this port to Shanghai in September. There are several "Strath" steamers in Pacific waters and the company will order whatever boats might be nearest at hand to handle the business when the time comes.

DR. RILEY SPEAKS OF THE LIFE TO COME.

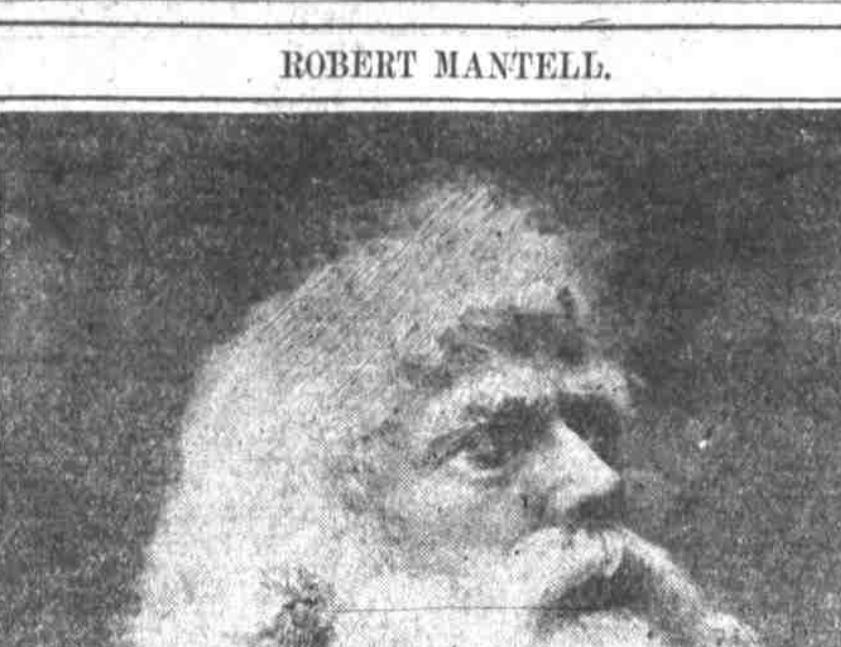
