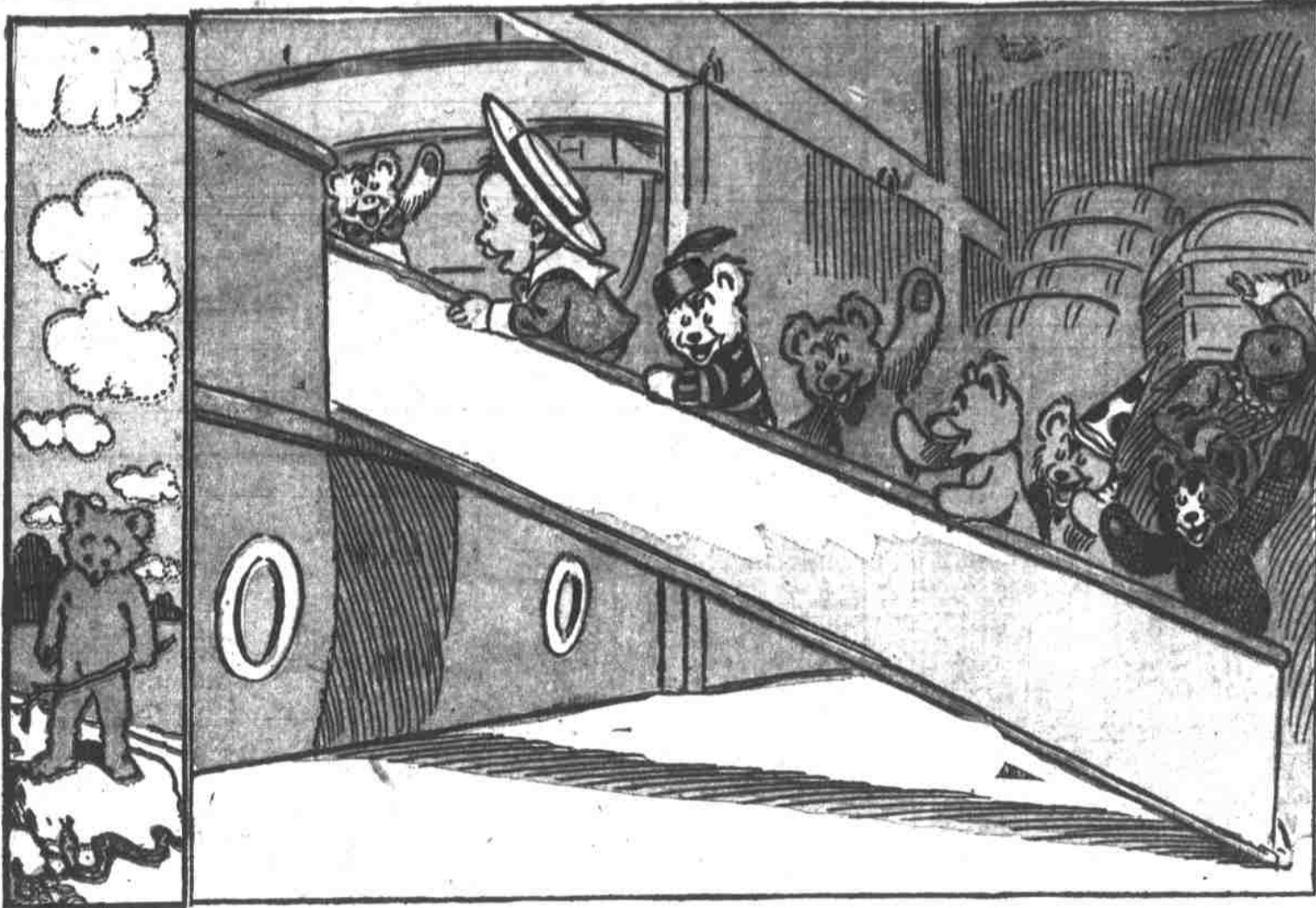
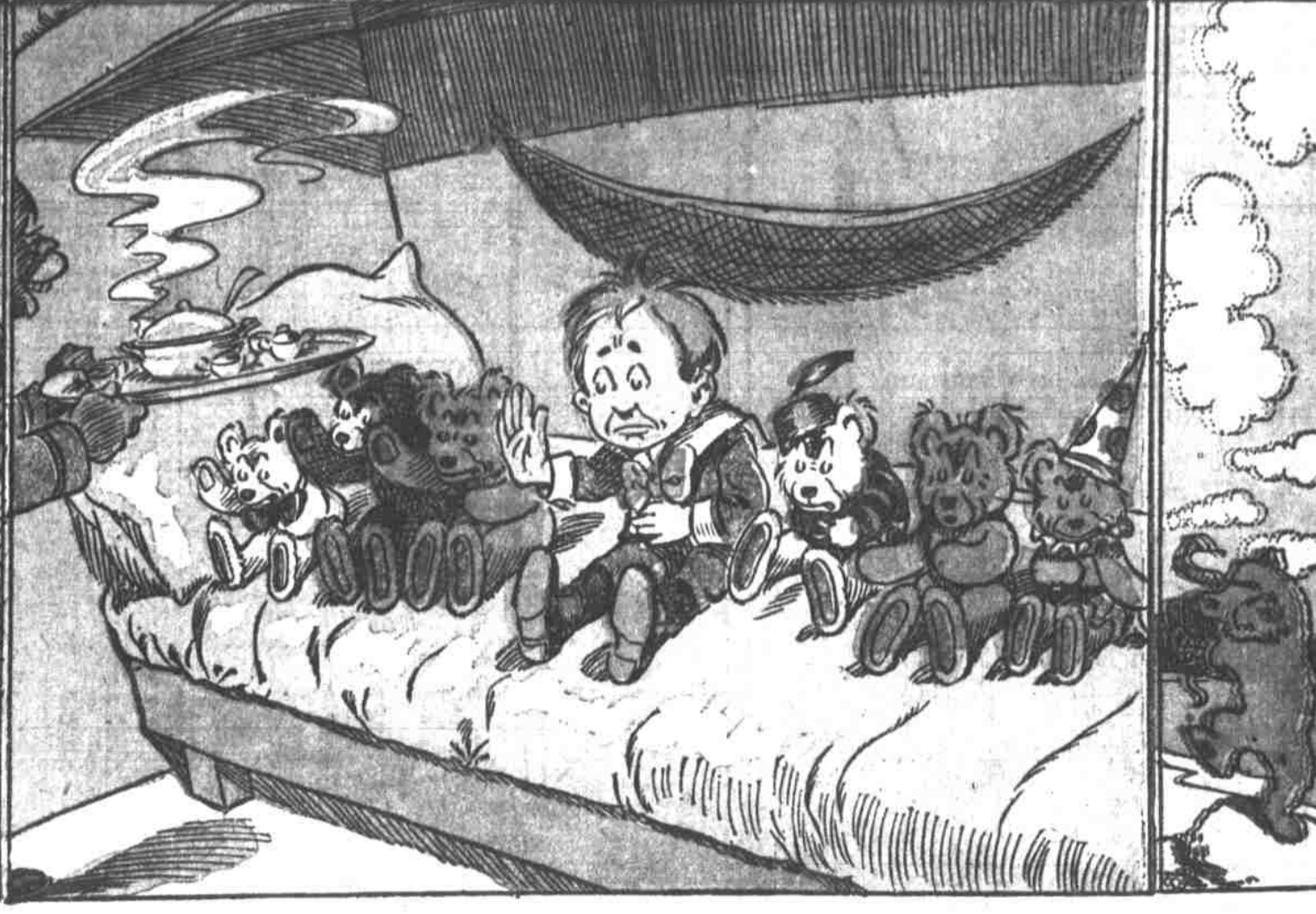

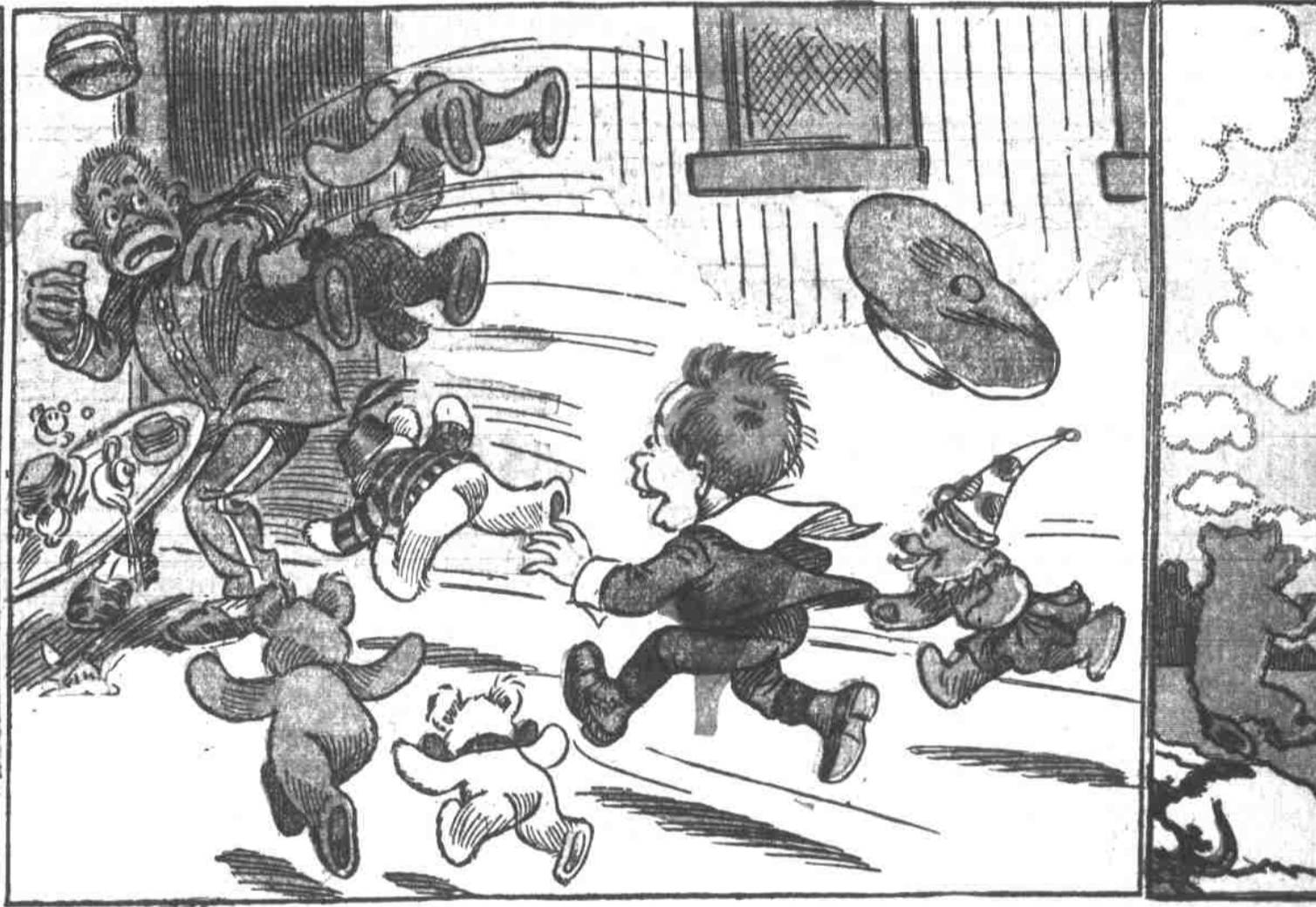
1. John's long vacation has begun;
