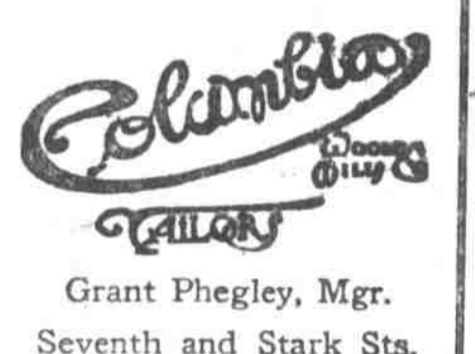

THE COMPANY'S POLICY. Our motormen and conductors are required to make a contemporaneous report of all accidents, giving full details and the names of all witnesses.

HOW THESE POLICY WORKS. Statistics show that in more than half the cases tried the plaintiffs get nothing from the jury and in a large proportion of the verdicts for the plaintiff, the amount recovered is less than the sum which could have been gotten without litigation.

HOW THE PUBLIC CAN HELP THE SITUATION. There are many ways in which the people interested in securing a square deal for good service can help the company.

(1) When you witness an accident, let us know whose the fault was. This does not mean that you will be making trouble for the conductor or the motorman, because allowances are made for mistakes.

(2) When the car you are about to take is crowded, wait for the next one, if you can do so without inconvenience; you will generally find a half-filled or empty car just behind.

(3) It is your right to have the car come to a full stop before you get on or off; do not attempt to board or alight from a moving car unless you are willing to assume the risk.

(4) Remember that riding on the back platform or on the running board is not safe. (5) Never cross a track when your vision of a car or wagon that may be coming in the opposite direction is obstructed.
