WILD GOAT PEST. Destroy Young Forest Trees—Hunting the Animals Popular. Honolulu Correspondence Forest and Stream. The wild goat or wallah has in recent years become a serious menace to agriculture in various parts of the territory. It is a native animal of the island of Hawaii, and is found in some instances ranging as high as 20 or 30 inches a month, the high sides in many cases being too steep for it.
