IDLE CARRIERS AT HOME PORTS

Portland Shipping Man Finds Poor Demand for Tramp Steamers.

BACK FROM VISIT IN OLD WORLD

Captain C. F. Hagemann Says Many Owners of Vessels Have Been Losing Money for Some Time but Look Forward to Better Times.

Shipping is very dull the world over, and strings of large steamers and sailing vessels are lying idle at home ports in Europe, according to Captain C. F. Hagemann, manager of the Shipping Supply company, who last night returned from a trip through England and Norway.

Low freights, he says, have sent the vessels home to await an improvement as soon as they have come within a reasonable distance. Instead of figuring large profits, ships in many instances pride themselves on having been able within the past several months to keep losses down to a small margin. But it is hoped that conditions will improve soon.

Mr. Hagemann was absent about four months, and during that time visited the principal ports of England and Norway after having spent some time in the larger cities on the way across the continent. At Tonsberg, Norway, he met Consul Wilhelm Wilhelmson, said to be the largest sole owner of steamships in the world, his fleet numbering close to 50 vessels. Many of them have been in Portland during the past few years, notable being the Terje Viken, Tricolor, Tellus, Thyra, Tiger and Tungus. Consul Wilhelmson said he intends visiting Portland next year.

At Thronthjem, Captain Hagemann met Captain Andersen, master of the American bark Astoria, which left here in the spring for the British Bay canneries after having been in the harbor all winter. Captain Davidson is in command of the vessel, and Captain Andersen's tour of the old world.

At Liverpool and London, Captain Hagemann met a number of shipmasters who have a large acquaintance in this city as a result of occasional visits in the wheat and lumber trade. All of them seemed pleased to hear from the Oregon port and their many friends.

In going through Norway, Captain Hagemann learned to his surprise that no automobiles are permitted within the limits of Bergen, although electricity is being put in evidence everywhere. He believes it the only place in the world where the popular electric trolley is being considered a dangerous device to roam about on the streets. It is supposed that eventually the objection will be overcome.

WITH THE LUMBER CARRIERS.

British Steamer M. S. Dollar Begins Loading at Linton. The British steamer M. S. Dollar reached Linton last night under charter to carry lumber to Shanghai. She began loading this morning the whole cargo to measure about 1,500,000 feet. The M. S. Dollar carries a crew of 41 Chinese. She is owned in San Francisco by the Dollar line, but flags to the British flag because of having been built in England.

The German steamer Eva shifted to the mills of the Oregon Lumber company this morning to finish her lumber cargo for the Orient and the British steamer, which is bound across the river to the mills of the Portland Lumber company to load for Copenhagen and Hamburg. Her berth at the mills of the Inman-Poulsen company was taken by the British steamer Duxbury, which came up from the drydock after having been repaired and painted. The Duxbury loads for Shanghai under charter to the Pacific Export Lumber company.

MUST OBEY RULES.

Local Inspectors Warn Navigators Against Violations. Local inspectors of vessels and Puller have issued a circular letter to owners and masters of sailboats on the Willamette river acquainting them with the rules of right of way and cautioning them against violations. The letter reads: "Your attention is called to the latest rules and regulations requiring all vessels propelled by sail to carry regulation side lights (not less than six

inches glass measurement) that is: They must be provided with a red light on the port side and a green light on the starboard side, which lights must be properly screened with screens extending not less than three feet forward of the light; the screen containing the red light on the port side to be painted red, and the screen containing the green light on the starboard side to be painted green. The screens to be so constructed as to show an unbroken light over an arc of the horizon 10 points. At a distance of at least two miles. These lights, and no other, shall be carried on all vessels propelled by sail between sunset and sunrise.

The inspectors have also issued a notice to the Willamette captains and pilots calling attention to the fact that there exists the following rule: "Unnecessary sounding of the steam whistle is prohibited within any harbor limits of the United States. When any licensed officer in charge of any steamer, tugboat or permit such unnecessary whistling, upon conviction thereof before any board of inspectors having jurisdiction such officer shall be suspended from acting under his license as the inspectors trying the case may deem proper."

AGREE UPON RATES.

Representatives of Trans-Pacific Lines Hold Conference. At a meeting held in Seattle yesterday afternoon between representatives of trans-Pacific lines running out of Pacific northwest ports it was agreed to establish separate rates for freight across the ocean upon breaking away from the railroad connections on November 1.

This means that from November 1 the interstate commerce commission will have nothing to say regarding the rates on the coast, as when through rates across the continent and ocean are quoted.

A spokesman, who represented the Portland & Astoria Steamship company operating out of this city at the conference, returned last night with the information that it was agreed to take the old ocean proportion of the through rates and add to it the proportional rate giving the through rate. As a general rule this combined rate will be a little higher than the through rates now in effect, but it can be changed any time without consulting the railroads or the interstate railroad commission.

The lines running out of San Francisco are not yet in on the agreement, and it is expected that they will accept the terms.
