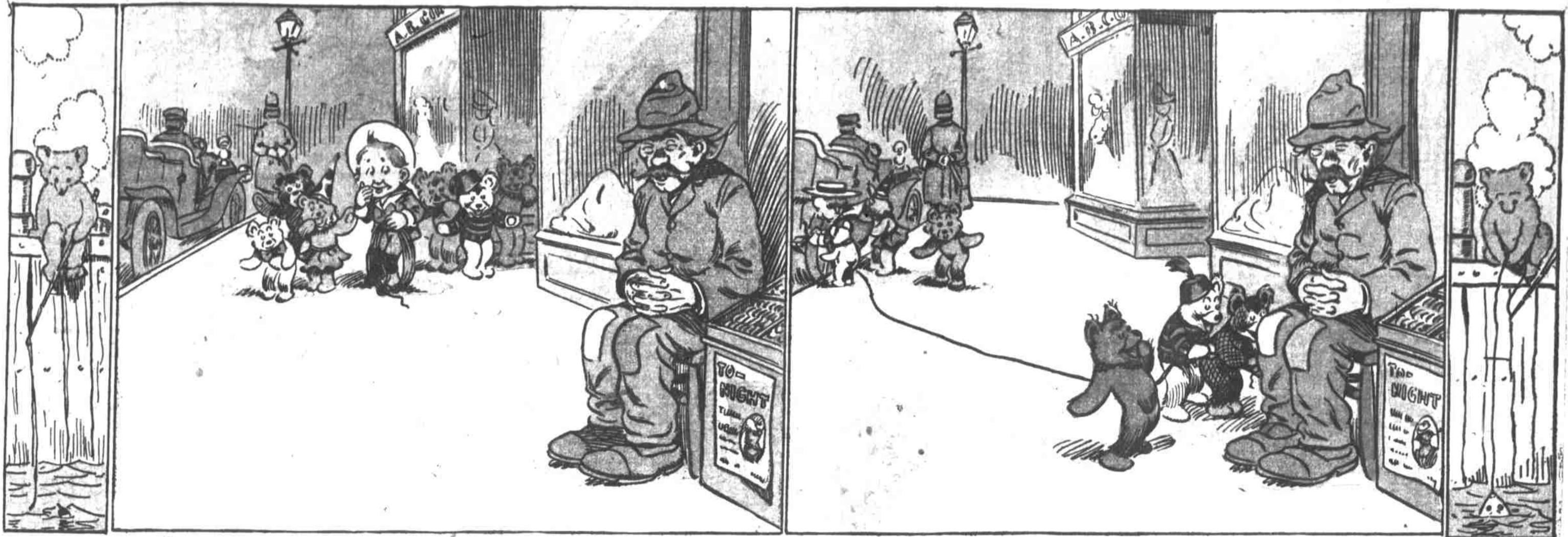
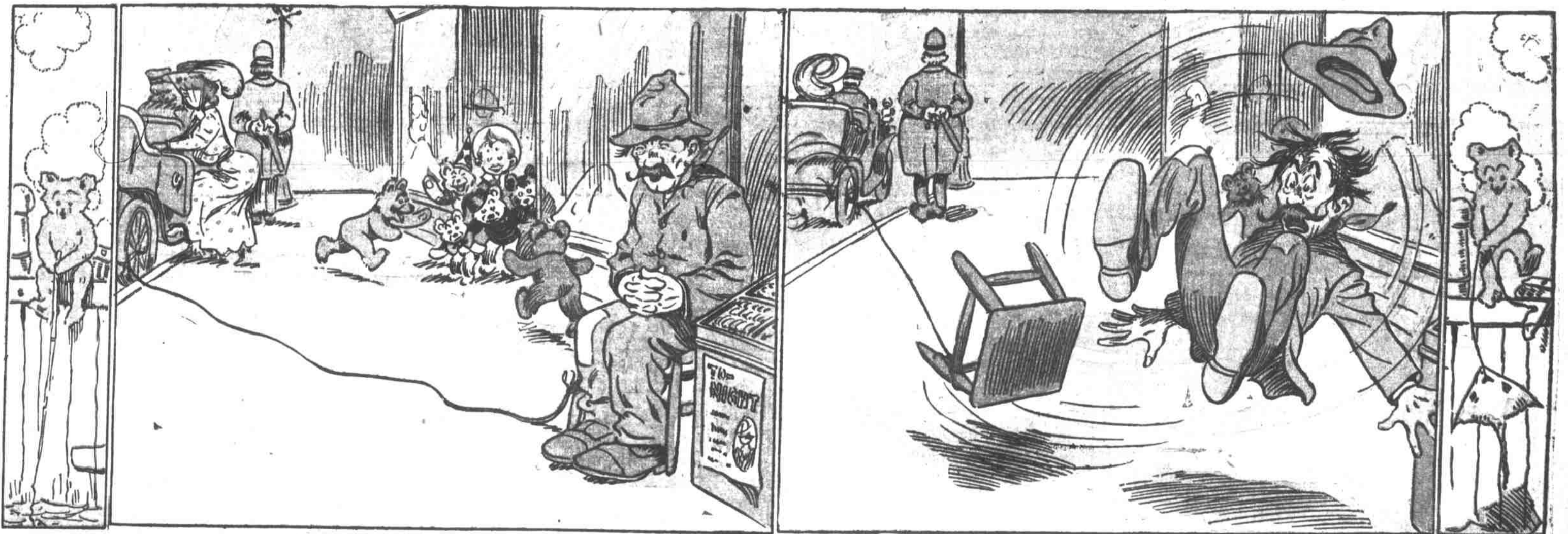

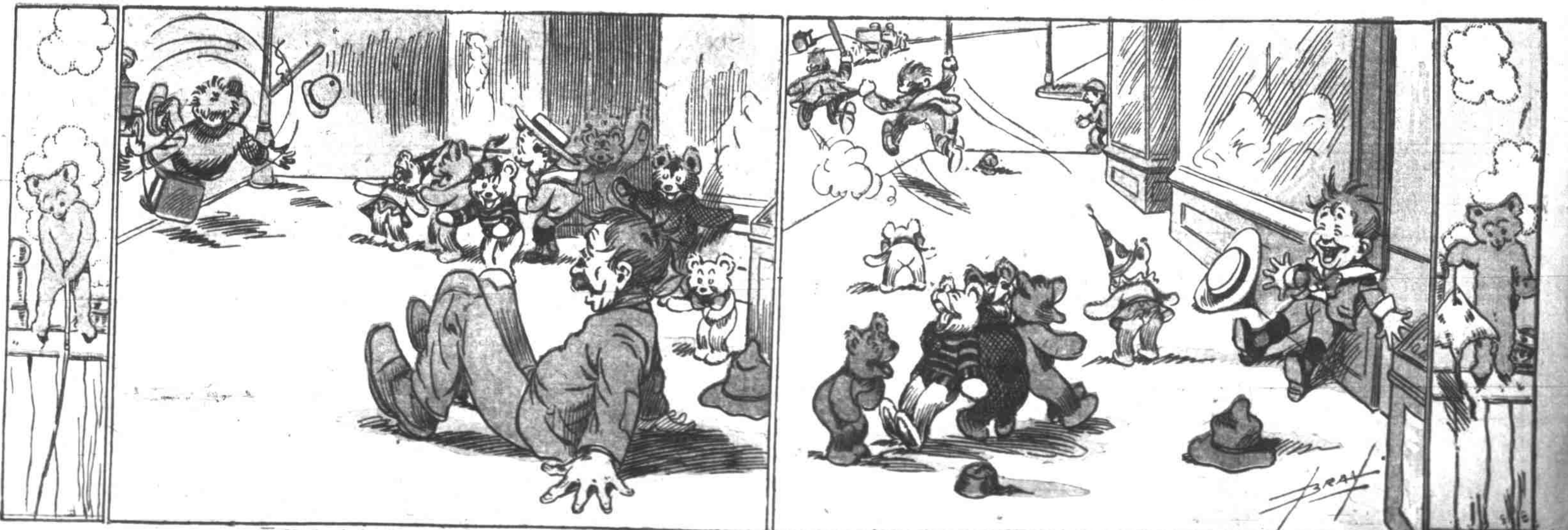
1. A homeless, sleeping peanut man
