

DIRECT WATER ROUTE VIA WINDJAMMER IS IN FOR WHEAT

Steamship Service to Be Inaugurated by the American-Hawaiian Line and Also Making Direct Communication With the Hawaiian Islands.

Commencing September 21 Portland will have regular 30-day steamship freight service with New York and other Atlantic coast ports by way of the Tehuantepec railroad.

This is a service for which Portland merchants have long been praying, because by it they will be able to handle increased trade now prohibited by rail rates and the uncertain method of transshipment.

Cook & Co., with offices in the Commercial club building, this city, are northwest agents for the American-Hawaiian line, and today C. D. Kennedy, who has charge of the local office, received the welcome announcement from headquarters through H. W. Roberts, who has charge of the company's Seattle office, Mr. Roberts appearing here in person to assist in arranging the schedule.

Every Twenty-One Days. Mr. Roberts in an interview this morning gave out the following statement: The American-Hawaiian line will have a regular steamer out of Portland every 21 days, calling here on the northbound trip, delivering freight from Atlantic coast ports and taking return cargo.

The steamer will come to Portland from Salina, Cruz, touching only at San Diego, making no stop at San Francisco. They will return to Salina, Cruz by way of Puget sound and San Francisco. At Puget sound they will have direct connection with the steamers Alaska and Alaskan to Hawaii.

British Bark Andorinha Arrives in Columbia River for Cargo.

FEARS FOR SAFETY OF THE ABERFOYLE Cement Laden Vessel Could Have Reached Astoria Several Days Ago—Left Hamburg in February With 20,000 Barrels of Cement.

The four-masted bark reported off the mouth of the Columbia river yesterday afternoon proved to be the large British bark Andorinha in ballast from Iquique. She crossed in during the evening. This adds further uneasiness concerning the safety of the British bark Aberfoyle, which is now out nearly 160 days from Hamburg for this port with a cargo of 20,000 barrels of cement.

The Andorinha comes under charter to Balfour, Guthrie & Co. to carry a cargo of wheat to Europe, and she is the first sailing vessel to reach here in ballast for new crop wheat. She has the reputation of having carried away the largest wheat cargo ever set afloat in this port on a windjammer and will therefore attract more than ordinary attention when she drops anchor in the harbor or comes alongside one of the grain wharves.

CARRIES CAPACITY CROWD.
