The flames soon crept up to her lifeless body and her right side which was lying toward the fire, was badly burned. Oscar Simpkins, a neighbor, heard the noise of the fire and rushed to the scene, finding Mrs. Meagerly's lifeless body lying in the edge of the flames. Help was summoned from Gold Hill and the coroner notified, but he did not deem an inquest necessary.
