Small Arrivals of Good Eggs. The arrivals of eggs are quite fair along the coast, considering the period of the year, but among the number of arrivals few are of best quality. This is causing most of the trade to discriminate against the poorer quality and it will pay shippers to see that the supplies arrive in better shape. Eastern eggs now being offered are generally of good quality because of the very careful handling but they are not nearly so good as the local because of the time lost en route.

Report of Individual Sales. A feature of general interest to the livestock growers is the agitation for the reporting of individual sale prices by the shippers. It is quite likely that the live system will soon be put into effect, and then shippers will know exactly what each individual animal has actually brought at the market instead of lumping the shipment as a whole.

# WHEAT TO SALTON SEA

## Flood Waters in Imperial Valley to Disappear by Evaporation.

Salton sea in California, the body of water that has given So. Calif. Irrigation engineers so much trouble for the past several years and that has built on its bottom large and valuable salt mines, will have disappeared within the next 12 or 15 years.

This is the statement made by Frank H. Bigelow, professor of meteorology, and one of the leading officials of the United States weather bureau, who is headquarters in Washington, D. C.

Bigelow is in the city today on his way to Klamath Falls where he will spend some time studying the cooperation in the reservoirs of the government irrigation project.

Professor Bigelow comes direct from his work at Salton sea and the statement is based upon an interview he gave out this morning. According to his observations, the water in the lake is disappearing at the rate of six feet annually although there is an outlet to the ocean, the New and Grand, however, empty their waters into the lake or it would disappear even sooner.

The lake is gradually being evaporated into the low land and the water is now becoming slightly brackish. Well developed salt mounds were flooded when the Colorado river broke into the low land and formed the lake and from these the water is gradually becoming slightly saline.
