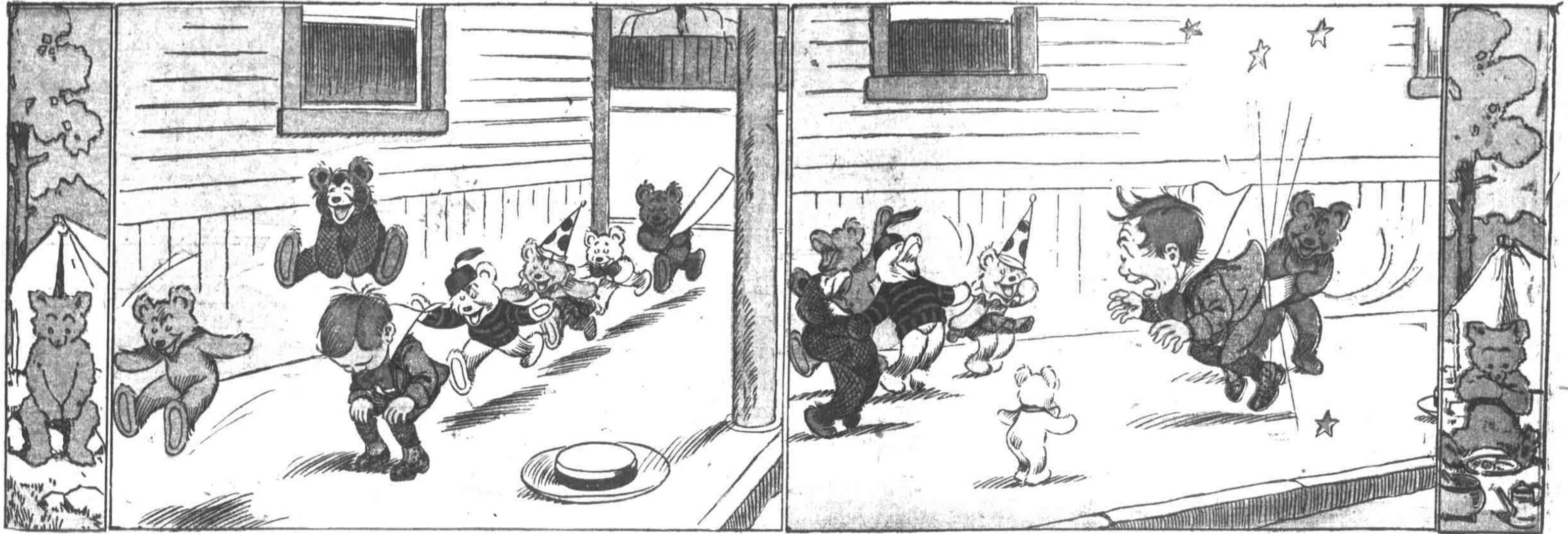
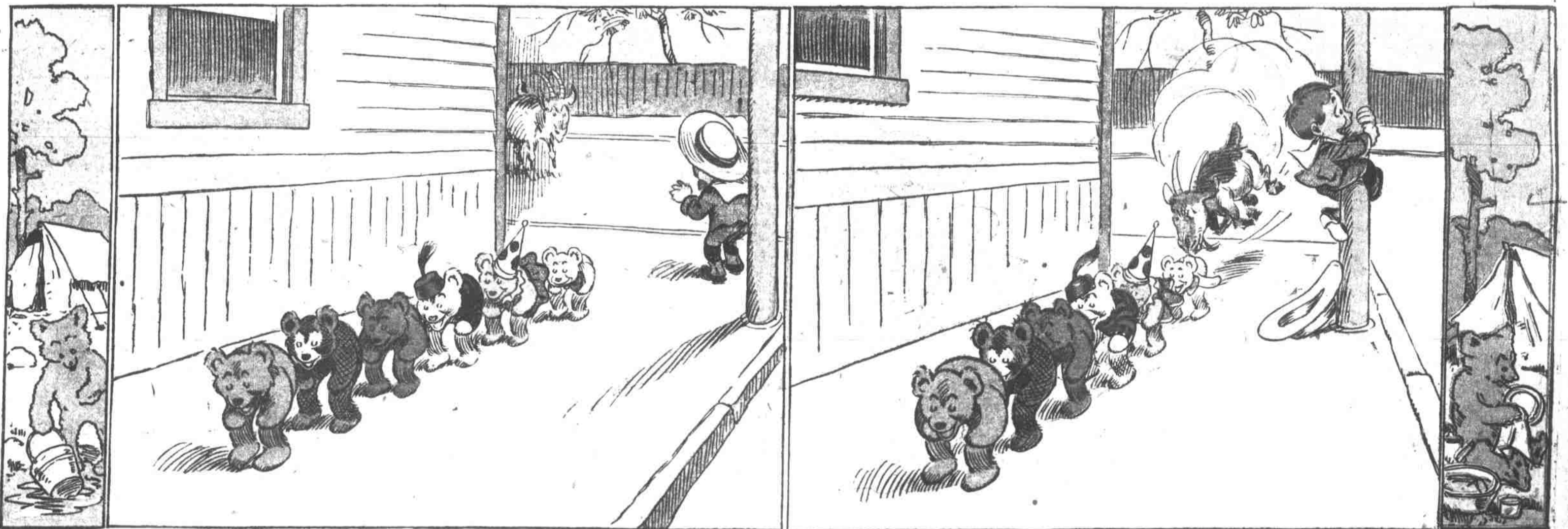

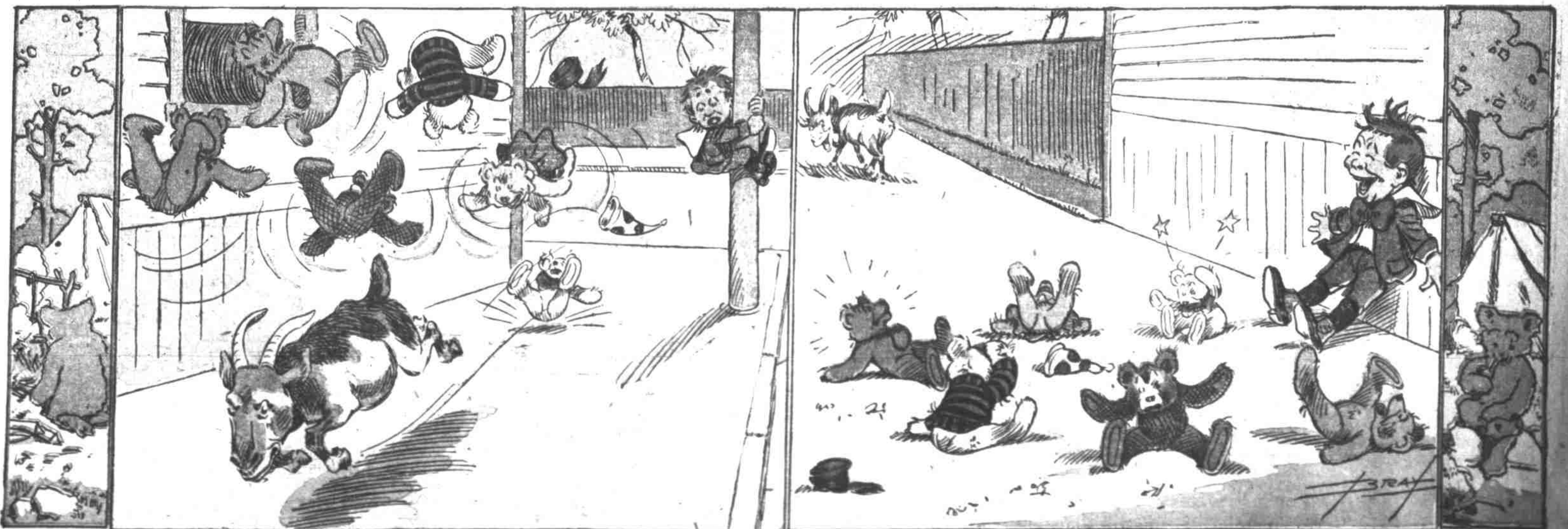
1. It is so fair this August day
