WHY NOT BE A BARREL SAYS AVERAGE COOPER

Washington, Aug. 22.--Tomorrow the International Coopers' union, some thousands strong in membership, will be meeting in annual session at Cincinnati. Already some thirty members of the union have figured that each hour of the session will cost \$50, every single minute one round dollar, and he has issued printed notices urging thoughtfulness and expedition in parliamentary practice on the part of the delegates.

There are some 2,000 coopers in establishments in the United States employed at \$3.00 a month, or annual wage of \$36.00, and putting out a product with a market value of \$100,000,000. The number of barrels and other products these men make every year approximates 150,000,000.

point of exportation. Staves sold last year to foreign countries were valued at \$5,127,822; headlands \$167,553. There were 1,300,000 fewer pieces shipped last year than there were the year before, yet the value was \$2,000,000 more.

Returns for Fiscal Year. For the past fiscal year the returns show that the hogheads and empty barrels sent out were valued at \$345,000 and other kinds of wood at \$1,684,353.

There is a great waste in staves and heading materials. Some of the lumber from the committee on the conservation of natural resources must devote an expedition to the study of the staves and heading materials.

Making Staves. In making staves, heading and hoops, some 14 different kinds of wood are used. Elm leads in stave manufacture in sheer volume, more than one fifth of the total output of staves being furnished from this species.

Valuable Barrels. The barrels produced every year are estimated to be worth about \$30,000,000.
