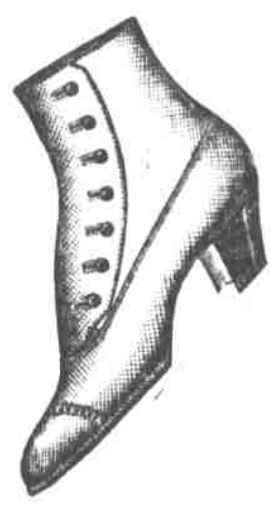

## FISHERMEN INDIGNANT OVER NEW LAW AND TROUBLE IS EXPECTED

(Special Dispatch to The Journal)  
The Dalles, Or., Aug. 27.—Fishing on the upper Columbia ceased at noon on August 25 in accordance with the old law which requires fishing to cease until noon on September 15. The new fish law passed under the initiative last June, which prohibits fishing on the Columbia above the junction of the Sandy River also went into effect on August 25. Some of the local fishermen seem to be of the opinion that as they have paid for a license which gave them the right to fish for one year from March 31, 1908, to March 31, 1909, the state cannot pass another law revoking the first law, especially as they have paid for the right. Accordingly, some of the fishermen contend they will have the right to fish until their licenses expire next March, subject, however, to the closed periods under the old law. In case of an arrest for a violation of the new law this would bring up a complex legal question.

An officer of the new law up-river fishermen got about off from fishing, and as many of the lower fishermen are very much dissatisfied with the last fish law passed under the initiative, prospects are that there will be an attempt to revise, for some of the disadvantages of the old law, and to improve the law for the benefit of the lower fishermen. In the meantime, the water will be thrown out to the courts.

Richmond, Va., Aug. 27.—Monticello, one of the historic homes of Virginia, where the great orator, Patrick Henry, lived, is to be burnt down by his great-grandchildren, because of an invasion of bats. Since the opening of spring it has been impossible to occupy any house in the neighborhood. The bats

have installed themselves by thousands in the drawing rooms and halls and bed chambers of this great building. All methods of destroying them seem equally useless. Poisons, sweepings and beatings fail of effect. They are found in long rows on the furniture on the walls and ceilings and even make such dense curtains on the windows that the rooms are darkened. The family see no way to be rid of the pest but to burn the house.
