Portland Union Stockyards, Sept. 5. With two days' holiday in sight—Sunday and Labor day on Monday—the arrivals of livestock in the local yards were quite liberal today. The run of sheep was especially good, 620 head arriving compared with 465 yesterday. Sheep prices are holding firm with best wethers readily moving at \$3.50.

Members of the street committee of the city council heard the objections of property owners on Tremont street yesterday in regard to the assessments for the street improvement. The chief objection was against the manner in which the assessment had been levied. The adjoining blocks are longer than the usual run city blocks and instead of providing for the assessment of property to the center of the block the ordinance covering the improvement provided only for those blocks which would cover the usual blocks of 200 feet.

Hop Pickers Show Discontent

The news from California brought up by the United Press and published in The Journal yesterday is having a depressing effect upon hop growers. The strike reports from the south have caused agitation among the local pickers, who went out this morning, and present indications are for trouble in the larger yards. The fact that one of the large yards has offered its pickers \$1 per hundred pounds has added fuel to the flame of discontent. While it is not expected that the smaller yards will be affected by any trouble from the pickers because most of them are operated by the families, it is not unlikely that the growers are paying over 80c per hundred pounds for picking this season. It is not likely that the price will not be able to make both ends meet at the present price of hops or contracts.
