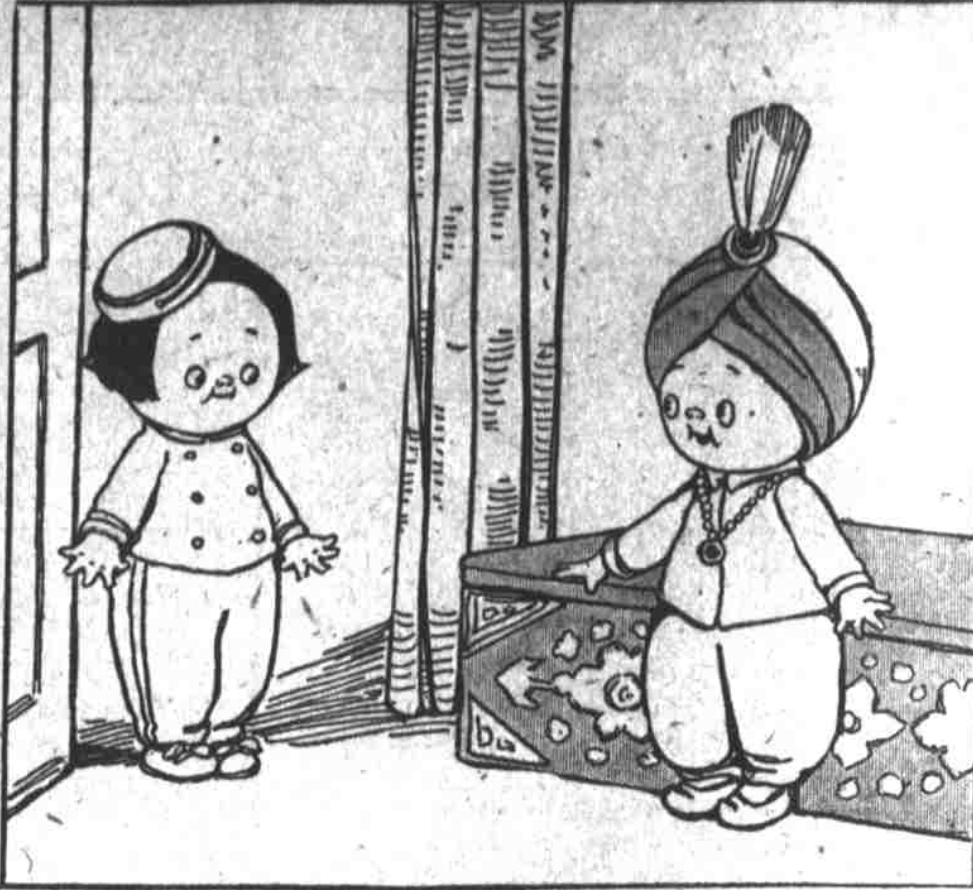

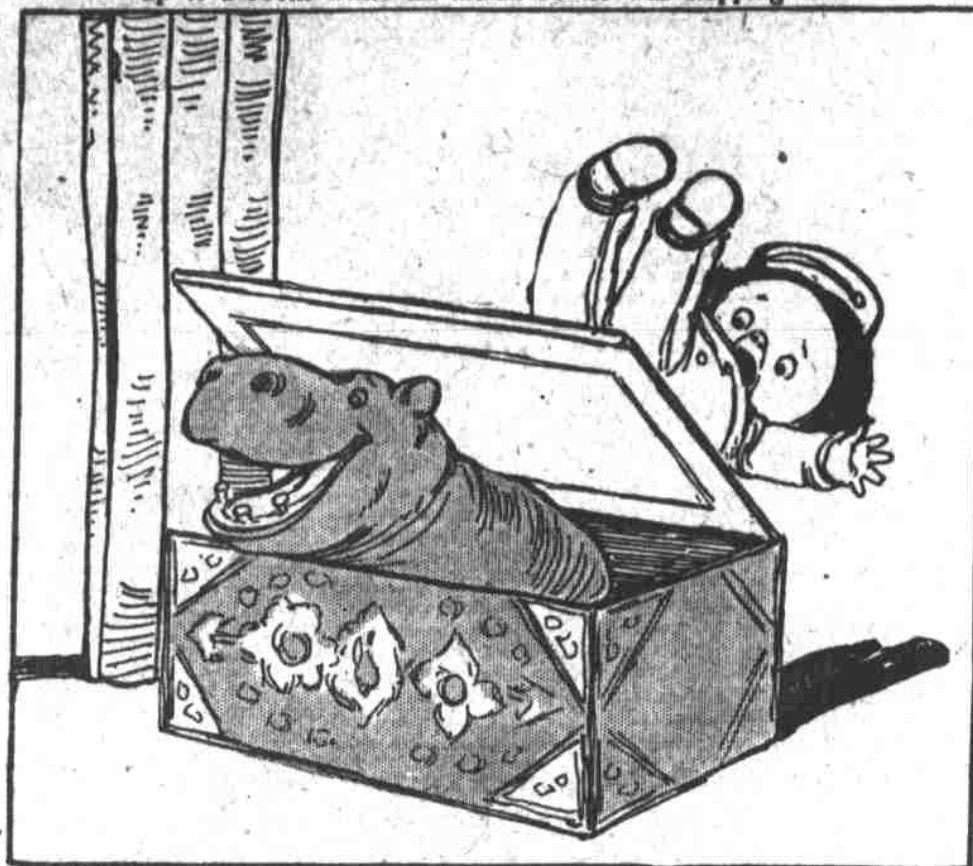
1. Supposin' you were a bell-boy in a hotel and the clerk told you to go up to a room where an Indian Prince was stopping—

6. Wouldn't you be glad if your mamma came rushing in and gave the hippopotamus a good spanking?

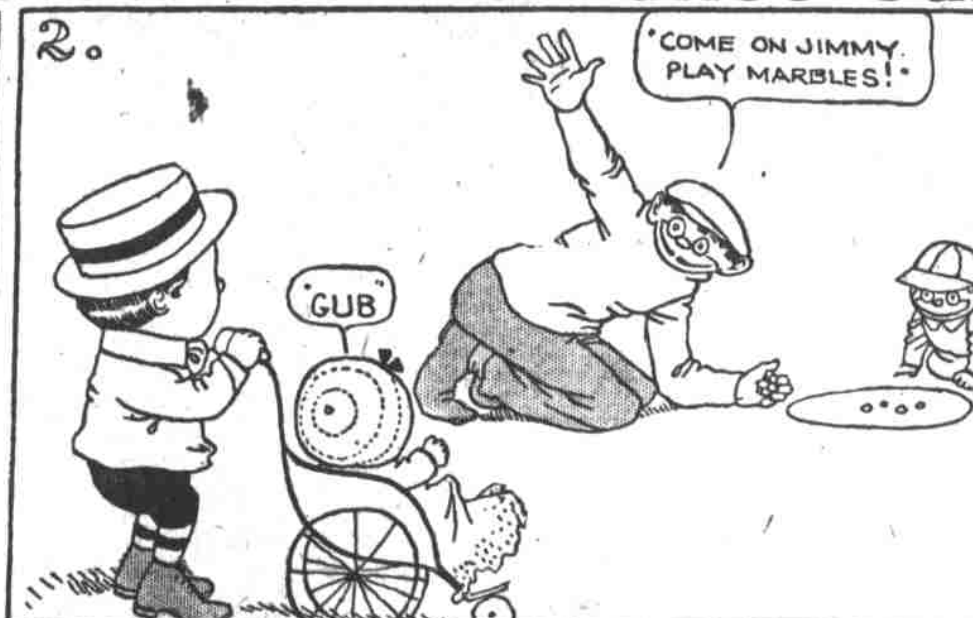

"MAYBE YOU GAVE IT TUH D'KID!"

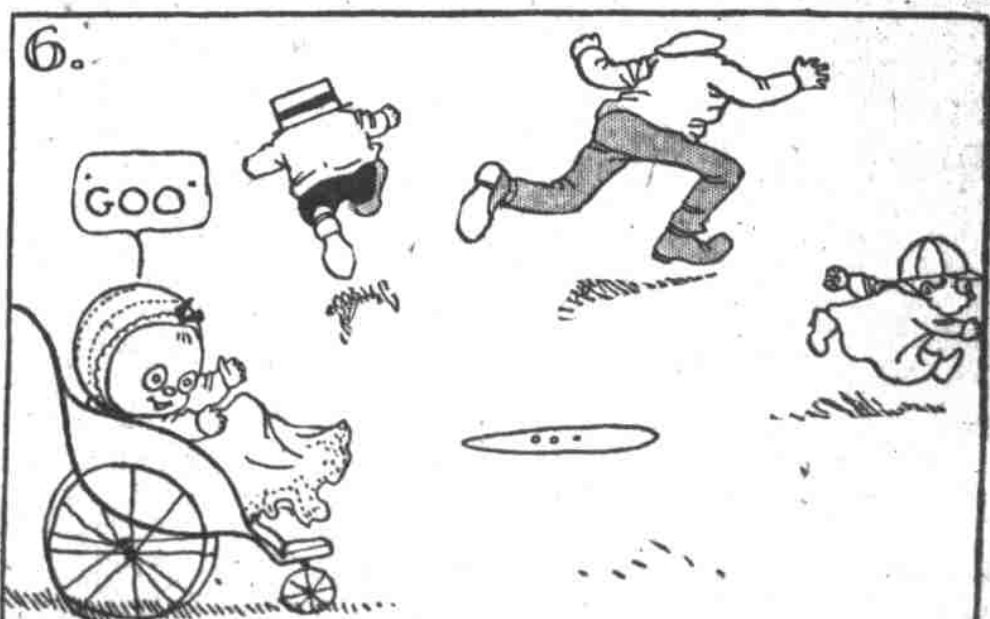

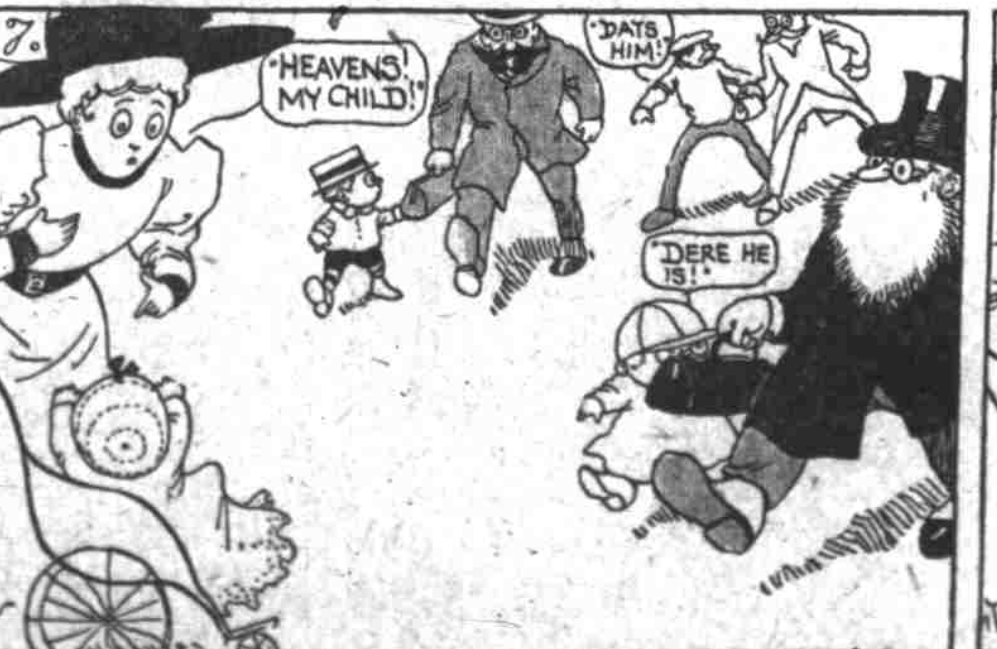
5. "HE MUST A SWALLOWED IT!"
