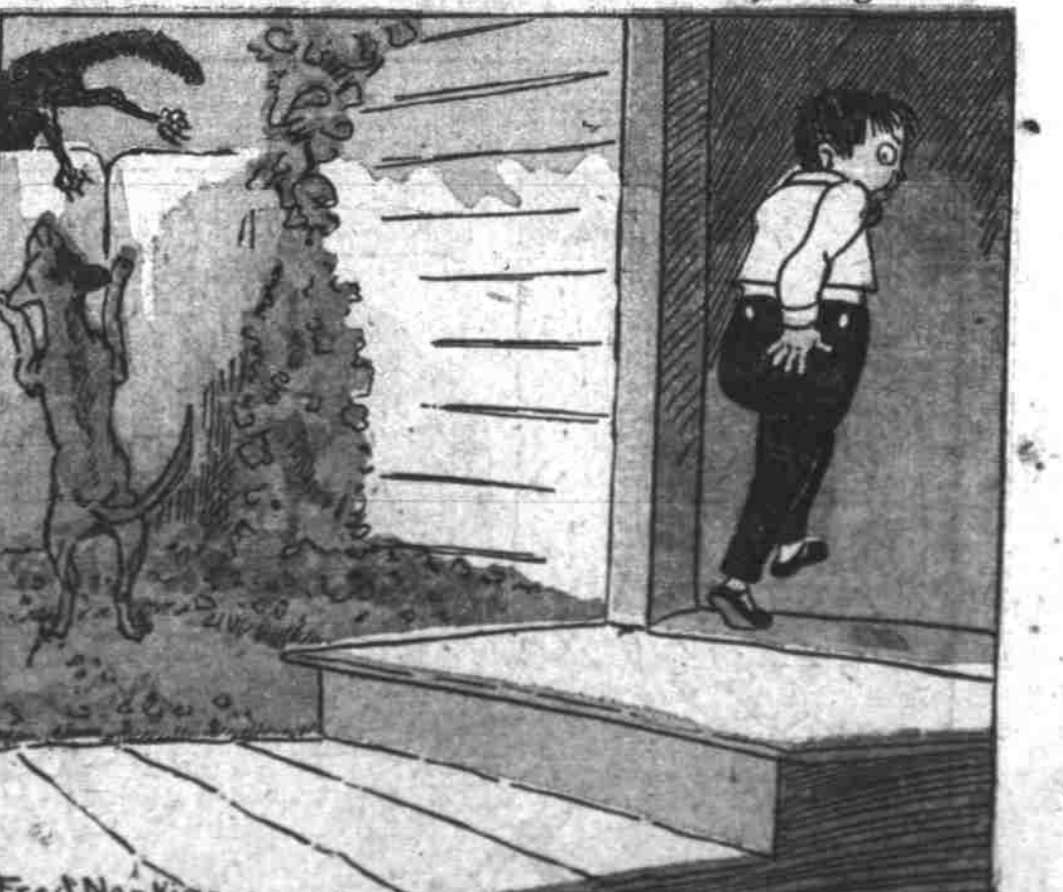
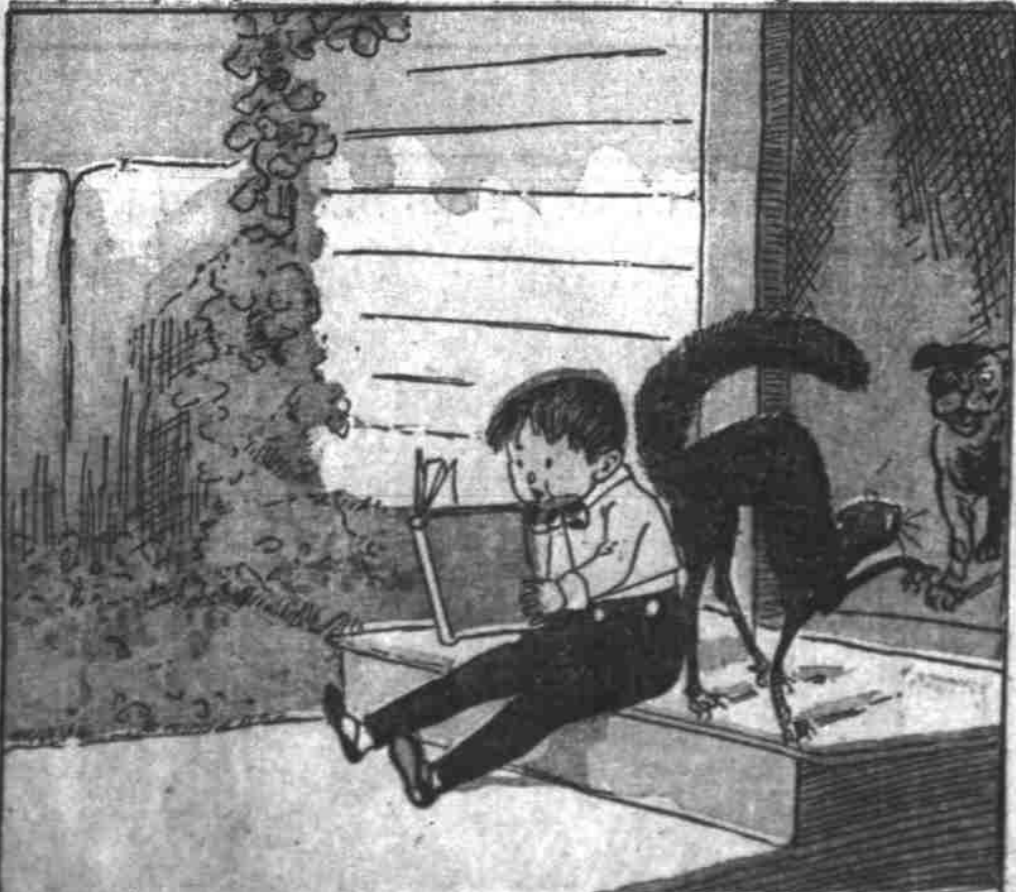
## TED'S OBJECT SPELLING LESSON--C-A-T AND D-O-G
