ITALY'S SONS TO CELEBRATE TODAY

Expected 4,000 Will Join Parade in Commemoration of Nation's Independence

Today is Italy's Natal Day, and it will be celebrated in grand style in this city. The occasion is of special significance here because of the presence in the harbor of one of Italy's men of war, the cruiser Puglia.

The parade will start at 3 o'clock from Italian consular corner Fifth and Couch streets, and take the following line of march: Couch to Sixth, to Alder, to Twelfth, to the exercises in Yamhill, to Thirtieth, to Washington, to Eighteenth, where the paraders will board cars for the fair grounds.
