"We didn't even lose a pet cat or get attacked by a parrot, did we, Jacoby?" said Madame Rappold when she stepped off the train this morning. "Let me see, didn't we lose a little curly-haired dog? Oh, I'm afraid we're awfully ordinary. Because nothing exciting happened." And she flashed a smile around on the company.

Without a doubt those four Metropolitan opera artists and their musical director, Mr. Rosenstein, are the jolliest, freshest-looking bunch of artists that have landed in Portland for a long time. They came in this morning from La Grande, where they gave a splendid concert last night to a large house. But, tired? Not if their looks and actions told anything. Only they did say they were glad to hear they would have two whole days in Portland. Mr. Rosenstein tried to pass it off as a compliment to Portland—their eagerness to remain here—but Rappold spoiled her coup d'état by saying the rest would be so good.

How the Stars Look.
They all point to Rosenstein as the clown of the company and the manager says whenever he has any bad news he tells Rosenstein and "Rosy" dresses up as a German comedian and makes them laugh so that they forget the import of his message. But they have all been blessed with their share of humor.

Madame Rappold, the fascinating soprano, sparkling with wit and laughs gleefully at everything. Madame Jacoby with a rich, purple-velvet voice, carries the point of the company, but there is a mischievous twinkle in her glances.

Mr. Rosenstein, the manager, is a tall, thin, dark man with a straight-from-Berlin nose, a jaunty

deviously over, his handsome dark face (I always thought before that bonafide tenors were pink and white and pale blue with plenty of embonpoint) bows gallantly and tries modestly to ward off the admiring glances with which he is greeted.

Signor Campanari listens most of the time, but when occasion warrants he smiles broadly to show that he understands the English, though for convenience he usually answers in Italian. And Rosy, the "little man," hops here and there, stumbling over obstacles and good naturedly offering to have his feet removed, and keeping everyone in good spirits.

First Venture of Its Kind.

The company stands in the way, but these people are comrades and they enjoy their concert together and laugh and joke over their mutual misfortunes. Most amusing to the women is the evident discomfort of the men when they have to appear in their dress suits to sing.

They stand with their arms fairly glued to their sides to keep from acting but even then sometimes they forget and their hands fly out in the impassioned gestures they have learned to indulge on the operatic stage. One of them said, "But now they are getting used to it. The women in their hand-some evening gowns are not so embarrassed at the changed conditions and they glory in their advantage."
