While of course the lower prices are the result of very heavy arrivals during recent weeks, the heavy arrivals are caused entirely by the high price of feed.

Rains have been general throughout the various wheat belts of the Pacific Northwest, and with the exception of Fall plowing will therefore go forward after much delay due to an unusually early summer, in which practically no moisture fell. The fall showers started much later than usual this season and on this account the delay in plowing for fall grain has been general.
