ADDED IMPETUS GIVEN PROJECT MOVEMENT AT VALE MEETING

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.)
Vale, Or., Oct. 14.—A mass meeting was held at Vale Saturday by the landowners of Malheur county for the purpose of organizing to revive the Malheur Irrigation project. The project includes about 100,000 acres of land. A committee was appointed to collect 10c per acre from the landowners and a donation from the business interests to put through the project. A petition was passed asking the government to again take up this proposition, assuring the support and cooperation of the landowners. Contracts were made which will be signed by the landowners to put their holdings in the hands of the government for irrigation. Every landowner will be seen by this committee. These contracts will be forwarded to the interior department. Messrs. Griffith and Hubbard, who did much of the promoting work for the Boise-Payette project, were here and promised the people their help in every possible manner. The petitioners ask that the government come in and take up the work where it left it off three years ago. They agree to use every means possible to get the lands cleared up, so that the government will have a clear field in which to operate.

TIES ARE BURNED BECAUSE THEY CAN'T BE GIVEN AWAY

Millions of old ties are burned every year along the right of ways of the railroad companies, or at least perhaps enough wood to supply half of Portland with fuel for an entire winter. Persons when traveling notice the ties burning beside the track, and are always wondering why in the world the railroad companies do not sell the wood or utilize it in some other way. "If the officials decided to sell the wood, these old ties and bridge timbers that would open up opportunity for graft with every section boss along the entire line," said a railroad man this morning, "and realizing this fact the companies have never sold their old ties."

They have tried giving them away. This also was a failure, strange as it may seem. It has been tried hundreds of times, and in most cases was a failure. When a farmer is given the old ties he promises to remove them from the right of way at once. In time, however, he usually picks out the best sticks of woods and leaves the others lying around carelessly. In many instances the farmer leaves the ties just where they are and forgets all about them. "So the railroad officials decided that all old ties should be burned."
