

MAP FREED FOR MOUNT SCOTT THEATRES TO VOTE ON CHANGES COSTLY MERGER

New Lines Projected and Under Construction Will Give State Mileage of Track More in Keeping With Its Size.

Oregon's reputation for having the smallest railroad mileage in the union in proportion to its size, with the exception of Nevada, will be lost before the end of the present fiscal year if the railroads now being projected for this state with Portland as their center, are constructed with anything like the feverish haste that has been displayed in securing rights of way and surveying routes through as yet undeveloped regions of the state.

Enforcement of Pending Fire Protection Ordinance Would Add \$25,000 a Year in Salaries to the Burden of City's Taxpayers.
