## J. HENNESSY MURPHY GRILLS M. C. GEORGE

I am pained, George, by the number among the hobbling and spavined old war horses who are trying to mouth away the patent insincerity and dishonesty of a discredited party. The younger and wiser leaders of your party—men now in harness—like Senator Bourne and Congressman Ellis and his party, know better. They probably have heard of Ben Butler's dictum, that "Whenever you go by a barnyard, hold your tongue to your nose." They know that the Republican party is now called upon to give an account of its stewardship, or all that remains of it outside of No. 18 Broadway.

The account of this stewardship is given in part in your letter to the Oregonian of Saturday last, for which every workman is indebted to your quill for the facts and your contentment for the record. To supply the facts and the record is the burden of this letter, which, briefly reviews with the object of summarizing the recent history of labor in labor disputes.

For more than two years past President

By a wrongful application of the injunction by the lower courts the workers have been forbidden the right of free press and free speech, and the supreme court in the latter case, while not directly prohibiting the exercise of these rights, yet so applies the Sherman law to labor that acts involve the use of free speech and free press and hit-and-run evidence upon which triple damages may be collected and fine and imprisonment added as a penalty. Indeed the decisions go so far as to hold agreements of unions with employers to maintain industrial peace to be conspiracy and the evidence of unlawful combination in restraint of trade and commerce, thus effectually throttling labor by penalizing as criminal the exercise of its normal rights and activities.

With this indictment of the injunction Mr. Gompers and his confederates presented themselves before the commission on platform at the national Democratic convention. But the agents of the "interests" were there and the labor leaders were turned down as Mr. Roosevelt was turned down. The "interests" framed up the platform and a sop was thrown to labor by a plank providing "that no injunction or temporary restraining order shall be issued without notice, except where irreparable injury would result from the delay." Yet President Roosevelt in his special message to congress on April 27 last, had declared that "It is un-

questionably true that, in a number of cases, this power (of injunction) has been used to the grave injury of the rights of laboring men."

What good then can come of a continuation of the "Roosevelt policies" direct and control the policy of his party and ignore Roosevelt's policies?

Mr. Gompers and the labor leaders then presented their case to the platform committee of the national Democratic convention and were successful in having a plank incorporated in the Democratic platform providing that "Injunction should not be issued in any case in which injunctions would not issue if no industrial disputes were involved" plenary provision for trial by jury in cases of indirect contempt.

The act of contempt committed outside the precincts of the court, but also declaring that "The parties to all judicial proceedings should be treated with rigid impartiality." And that's all the

labor leaders asked from either platform committee; that is, a square deal and to be treated with "rigid impartiality" and not to have the writ of injunction used as an engine of tyranny against a particular class—the labor unions—as Candidate Pitt himself admits has been done in his letter to the platform also declares, respecting the Sherman law. "There should be no abridgement of the right of the wage earners and producers to organize for the protection of wages. The Republican platform is not explicit."

Commenting upon the provision, "For trial by jury in cases of indirect contempt," you declare with great impressiveness in your letter to the Oregonian: "Never has such a thing been done in any country, or even in any Democratic state or Democratic territory."

"Ach, iss dot so?" I believe there is a maxim of the law which states: "No man should be judge in his own case." Maybe it's good men and true haven't as much grace as one judge. However, if something pretty close to it has not been done, you can charge it up to the supervisory of the Republican party or the "interests" that control it, for in his special message to congress of April 27, President Roosevelt declared:

"First as to the power of injunction and of punishment for contempt, in contempt cases, save where immediate action is imperative, the trial should
