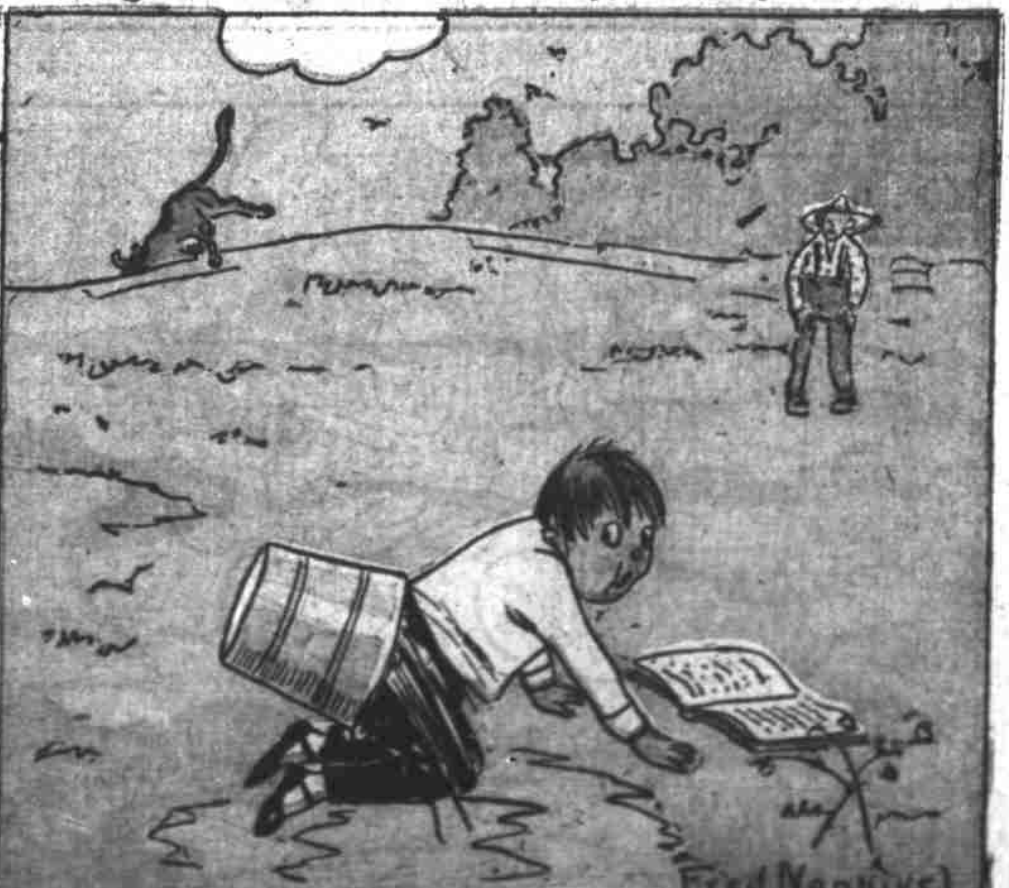
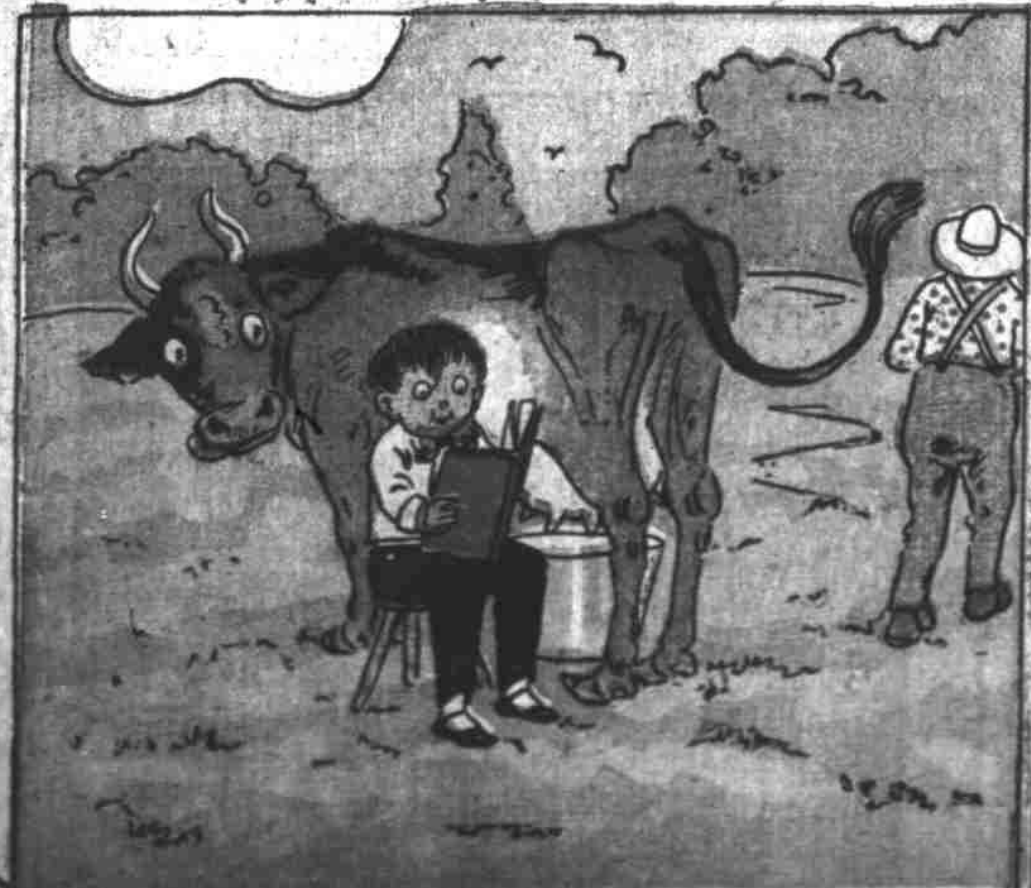
### TED'S OBJECT SPELLING LESSON---C-O-W AND M-I-L-K
