FOLLY OF REPUBLICAN LEADERS

Prominent Member of Party in Oregon Boldly Tells Why He Refuses to Take Stump for Taft—Writes Letter to the State Committee.

Not all prominent Republicans of Oregon are "in line." Some of them do not fall in with the idea of a Roosevelt dynasty. Some of them will not take the stump for Taft because they do not like the way he was nominated, some because they do not like the platform upon which he is running and some because they do not like the Republican and quibblings of that platform.

Within the last few days the Taft managers of Oregon sent an invitation to "well known" speakers in Portland, prominent as a Republican of long standing and firm party loyalty in the past, to make the stump in the name of the effort to stay the Bryan sentiment which is flooding the state.

Asked to Excuse Folly. "And now we are asked to excuse this folly, to explain our failures, to record our past violations, and suspicion of future bad faith—to a people reeling from the commotion of a party self-respecting instinct of citizenship.

The manner in which Mr. Taft was forced upon the party by Theodore Roosevelt, the undignified and unbecoming vilification of party service by executive aspersion, the insane posing of campaign responsibility, by which political jobs were sought, the reckless use of borrowed greatness, presents a picture too grotesque to inspire confidence, too serious for unrestrained hilarity.

As to Banking Laws. "With the record of bank binding before our eyes, what excuse have we for the absence of a guaranty in our platform because a few bankers at Denver resolve that such a plank should be discarded, and themselves and assert that Bryan means no harm, is no excuse for tying up our funds, impoverishing our people and ruining the credit of the state.

Worse Than Platform. "And Mr. Taft's attitude on this question is still worse than the platform. It is a little short of mockery and leaves nothing to hope for but perpetual submission to the unbridled and unbridled rapacity and industrial delirium.

When a man has been a consistent hater of Grover Cleveland, a follower of Lincoln and of Blaine, and ever a warm admirer of Roosevelt, it is hard for him to face such a situation and admit his confusion when he is looking for constructive leadership and militant progressiveness amid the internal evaporation of the political machine.

We are pursuing a policy of public extravagance to meet which a tariff for revenue only would mean incidental protection; and this, too, with no compensating benefits. We are attacking every meritorious enterprise in which capital is entitled to develop commerce, and we are so hampering and limiting the possibilities of individual initiative and competitive endeavor that socialism follows in our furrows as the legitimate harvest of a paternalism too weak for the maintenance of its too glutinous parasites.
