

NO INCREASE TAFT'S ELECTORAL VOTES IN LAND SALES

Report of State Land Board Shows That 243,216 Acres Have Been Sold During the Past Two Years—School Fund.

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.) Pendleton, Or., Nov. 2.—E. L. Smith, one of Umatilla county's most prominent farmers and capitalists, president of two banks in the county, and a heavy stockholder in several others, declared today that if the people fail to endorse Mr. Bryan's position on the guaranty of bank deposits he will immediately retire from the banking business.

Mr. Smith's statement was made at the Republican headquarters just after the pioneer farmer had delivered one of the strongest Democratic talks of the present campaign to his nephew, Ernest Ruppe, secretary of the Taft & Sherman club, and several other voters who happened to be present.
