GREAT CROWDS BLOCK STREETS IN FRONT OF ALL BULLETIN BOARDS

Everyone who was able to sit up or walk out watched for the election returns last night. The streets about the center of town were almost impassable and there insisting on leaving an open passageway through the crowds for the moving portion. The street corners around the stereopticon bulletins were naturally the most crowded, though a restless crowd paced back and forth through the streets, tooting horns or vigorously shaking cowbells. As the evening progressed the din increased and reached its climax about midnight. For those who did not venture downtown, the large searchlight on the top of the Journal building, indicated by its horizontal sweep the course of the election, and the calcium light effects from the Oregonian tower showed at stated hours what candidate was in the lead. But most of the town was downtown watching the detailed returns and keeping up their spirits with the moving pictures and cartoons shown between returns. The Journal threw the telegraphic dispatches on a huge screen over the Gas company's building. Scenic views, cartoons, photographic productions of the two candidates' speeches and music by the Journal carriers' band provided entertainment for the large crowd that gathered there. The stereopticon used by the Meier & Frank company was especially effective. The telegraphic returns were handed quickly and showed up well on the big canvas. Special care had been taken with the moving pictures and the cartoons shown were very effective. Other places where stereopticon returns were shown were the Oregonian building, Moore's drug store, and the Bijou theatre. Bulletins at the re-

turns were kept posted all evening at the Commercial club, the Republican and Democratic headquarters, the Hazelwood store, and the various hotels. Crowds were gathered about all these places, but there was no disturbance of any kind. The throng was orderly and though the police moved about constantly watching, there seemed no crying need for their presence. Cheers frequently rent the air as the likeness of one or the other candidate was thrown on the canvas. A favorite Republican device was to follow a Taft majority with a cartoon of President Roosevelt with his "De-lighted" expression, saying "I told you so!" The crowd remained on the streets till almost midnight when the result of the election had been settled beyond a doubt. Far into the night or rather into the morning the sounds of belated or straggling horns might be heard on their joggly way homeward, and an unmistakable tremor marked most of the late music. MOTHER SEES SON A SUICIDE

Miller G. Scouten Stands in Her Presence as He Fires Fatal Shot.

(United Press Leased Wire.) Bellingham, Wash., Nov. 4.—Miller G. Scouten, a wealthy real estate dealer, returned home at 3 o'clock this morning and killed himself in the presence of his crippled mother. He was despondent over reverses and disappointments had been prevailing on his mind for months. He shot himself in the right ear and fell at his mother's feet. She was scarcely able to leave her chair, but hobbled to the telephone and called Chief of Police Croslin. Scouten died three hours later at the hospital without regaining consciousness.

VOTE MACHINE GOES CRAZY IN ITS INSIDES

(United Press Leased Wire.) Berkeley, Cal., Nov. 4.—An error in regulating the internal mechanism of the voting machines in Alameda county to respond with the ballot keys on the face of the machines was discovered today in the recount of the votes. When the machines were installed in booths they were so adjusted that keys regulating the voting on the Republican candidates for superior judgeships, Everett J. Brown, William H. Waste and

T. M. Harris, reversed the individual vote registered for the candidates. The ludicrous result was that Waste was outvoted by Harris and Brown in his own home at Berkeley. Brown received the fewest votes in his home at Alameda and Harris got a scattering vote in the south end where he is strongest. A reversal of the mechanism and a recount will right the mistake. Cummins for United States senator at the primary yesterday and the election of Taft and Governor Carroll, leaving the party in its former complete control in the state. It is thought the selection of Cummins will put an end to the bitter feud that has existed so long between the standpatters and the progressives in the party. It is believed the old trouble that kept the legislature deadlocked for weeks this fall will not reappear.
