CONGRESS OF MOTHERS WANTS KINDERGARTENS IN CITY SCHOOLS

The matter of incorporating kindergartens with the public school system was presented this afternoon at the Congress of Mothers at the regular meeting held in the rooms of the Associated Charities.

Agitation on this subject was begun last year and the many societies inter-

ested in this phase of education made an effort to obtain it, but as their petition was not circulated early enough, they failed to bring it before the taxpayers. This year it is probable that a more determined effort will be made. It will be necessary for some number of people interested in the matter, as of the Congress of Mothers, the Froebel society, the Home Training association or some other body, to circulate a petition and obtain the signatures of a large number of taxpayers. If this petition, properly indorsed is presented to the school board it will probably be recommended to the taxpayers, and will then be given a place on the ballot at the regular school election in June next.
