40 CENTS FOR OUR BEST EGGS WILL BE IN NEW MARKETS MARCH

Advance of 21-2c Dozen Is Quoted by Local Trade—Turkeys at 20c Pound.

PORTLAND WHOLESALE MARKETS.

Eggs move to 40c a dozen. Dressed turkeys at 20c. Big sale of hogs reported. Fish supplies still scarce. Apples sell rather low. Shrimp advanced. Tangerines come more freely. Grapes sell at fabulous figures. Potatoes are weakening. More California onions coming.

Advance in Egg Market.

There was an advance of 21c a dozen in the price of local ranch eggs this morning along Front street, although some of the dealers say they can not secure the eggs were purchased at rather low prices, and for that reason the sellers are quite willing to accept an ordinary profit, and few of them are showing any advantage of the higher figures now in effect all through the east.

Best Dressed Turkeys at 20c.

Best dressed turkeys are today selling in the Front street markets at 20c a pound. The exorbitant figures supposed to be ruling are merely supposition, for the dealers are not showing more than 20c. Some stock, dressed, does not command as high a figure; in fact most of the arrivals will be under the top. Thus far only a small percentage of the arrivals have been of first class quality, the percentage of "culls" being much heavier than usual.

Big Sale of Hops Reported.

The largest individual sale of hops in the state this season has been reported by C. A. McLaughlin sold 1,600 bales to John Carmichael of Salem, who represents Wm. Richardson & Co. of London. The purchase was made on a basis of \$10 for 1,200 bales, and \$8 for 400 bales. This is likewise the heaviest purchase made by European since this season, and indicates that the price of hops is on a debatable ground. Growers generally are not showing any interest in the present market, and dealers are likewise willing to do business. Besides the McLaughlin sale several other transactions have been reported during the past 24 hours. This was forecast in the report yesterday. Most of the sales are being made at a profit, and the former for medium and the latter for ordinary prices.

Apples Sell Rather Low.

In order to shift a portion of the accumulated holdings several Front street houses sold apples at a reduction of about 25c a box today. Quite fair Spitzenberg were sold at 10c a box, while ordinary stuff sold lower in some cases. The grape market is in a panic condition, and sales are being made in some instances at lower than cost price. One instance of this nature was reported during the past 24 hours. A packer of 100 boxes of grapes for 60c a box was sold at 10c to lay down here a short time ago.

Crabberries Show Still Advance.

Telegraphic advices received from the east by local brokers this morning state that cranberry prices here range from \$1 to \$1.25 a barrel higher than they were a few days ago. This is one of the strongest advances shown in the market for some time, and indicates that the crop is not nearly so heavy as expected. On the account of local buyers' demand with the price showing a disposition to follow the lead of the eastern advance.

Brief Notes of the Trade.

More shipments of onions from California are expected. Third holders of potatoes are offering at a cut of 10c because of the glutted condition of the market both here and in the south. Tangerines are arriving more freely from California and are selling quite a good sale around \$2.25 a crate. Salmon supplies remain scarce. Front street markets at the following prices.
