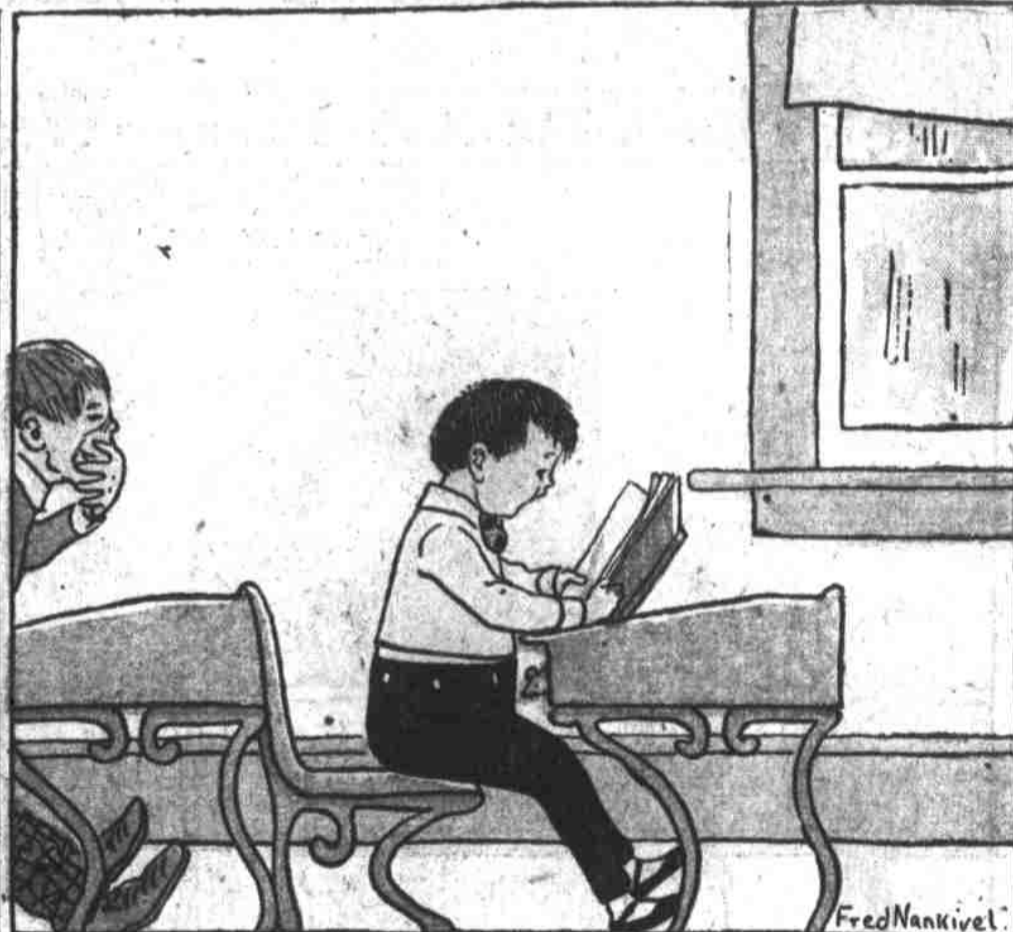
TED'S OBJECT SPELLING LESSON--R-A-T AND T-E-A-C-H-E-R

"Say, here, Ted, is the thing you spelled, a rat—a pet one, too; A white rat with pink ears and nose—you take it. Here, please do."



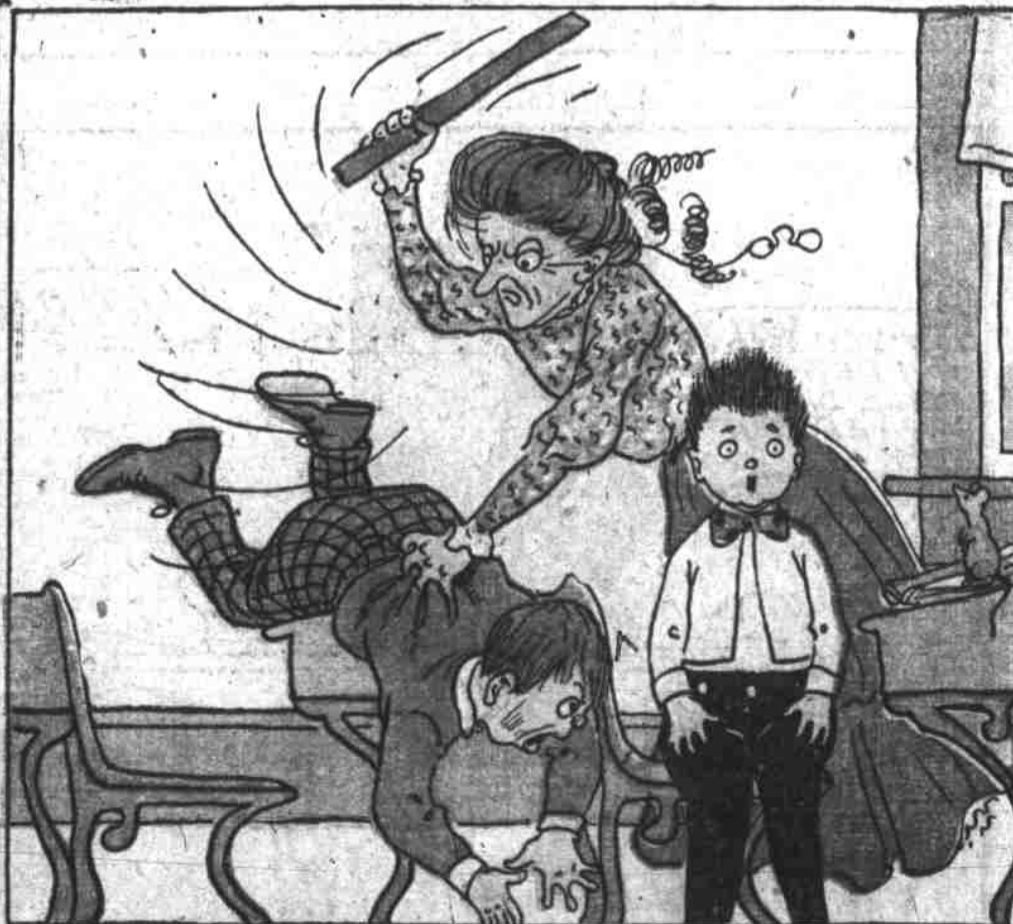
"Now T-E-A-C-H-E-R is a long word to spell, And what it is I do not know; I wish that I could tell."
