

SAYS UNION MEN FRIGHTENED CREW

Captain Knudsen of the Schooner W. H. Talbot Explains.

RECOGNIZED ONE AS FORMER EMPLOYE

Declares Attempt to Shift Blame on Outsiders Is Unfair in View of Fact That He Is Positive of Facts—Vessel at Astoria.

Captain A. Knudsen, master of the American schooner William H. Talbot, which is at Astoria waiting for the storm to abate before starting on a voyage to Manila, with a cargo of lumber, in a letter to The Journal states that it was union sailors who intimidated his crew to leave the vessel when she was ready to sail from the mills of the Portland Lumber company a week ago.

Business Agent D. J. Paul, of the Sailors' union, stated some days ago that he had been able to obtain no information proving that the men who appeared on the mill wharf and enticed the non-union crew away, were union men. In fact, he was positive that they were not, although the sailors who say they were frightened away, say these men declared themselves to be members of the union.

Captain Knudsen's letter follows: "Astoria, Or., Nov. 23.—To the Editor of the Journal:—In your paper of the 20th inst., I read an article headed: 'Union not to blame. New light thrown on schooner W. H. Talbot case.' I would like very much to know who has thrown this new light on the case. 'If the Sailors' union agent has anything to do with it, I do not know, as he was not present at that time, but you can tell him from me that there is no getting out of it that members of the Sailors' union did the mischief and are to blame for the whole thing. I suppose Mr. Paul, the union agent, thought this the cheapest way out of it, thinking that the vessel was gone and that there would be nothing said against the new light thrown on the case, but it happens that I have been delayed here on account of rough weather, and consequently I am able to make this statement. AIDS FOR PUGET SOUND

Board Approves Recommendations of Lighthouse Inspector Pond. The lighthouse board of the United States has approved the recommendations made about a month ago to establish a number of new and improved aids to navigation in the waters of Puget sound and adjacent borders, and the lights will be placed unless congress fails to make the necessary appropriation next session.

Cries for better lights along the shores of Puget sound have been made for a long time although the best possible that the money available would permit has been done, and about a month ago Captain Pond made a personal investigation with the result that if congress appropriates the money, the following aids will be established: Point Herron—Acetylene gas beacon with occulting light and automatic fog signal bell.

Point Glover—Same as Point Herron. Double Buoy—Bell buoy. Apple Cove Point—Same as Point Herron. Bush Point—Same as Point Herron. Post lantern to be discontinued when the beacon light is established. Marrow Stone Point—Present lens lantern and fog signal to be replaced by

A fourth order light and a third class Daboll trumpet. Point Partridge—Light vessel. Dallas Bank—Bell buoy. Slip Point—Present lens lantern light and third class Daboll trumpet to be replaced by fourth order light and first class automatic siren.

ROW AMONG LINERS

Competition Figures in Arrival of British Steamer Uganda.

The British steamer Uganda, which arrived here this morning, came near having a war on board this morning, two rival ship lining factions contending that they were entitled to the work of placing the inside of the hold, in shape to receive wheat cargo.

The steamer arrived in the river last night and went to Linton, where one firm does its unloading. This morning another firm appeared on the scene and secured the steamer and she was taken to the Eastern Western mill. The squabble delayed the craft about four hours.

The Uganda is here from Nansalmo, B. C. in ballast, under charter to Kerr, Gifford & Co. to carry grain to Europe, and had an exceedingly rough trip from the British Columbian port. She started out last Saturday and had to buck the heavy southeaster all the way.

Wave after wave swept the decks, although the steamer rode high, and everything was flooded. No particular damage was inflicted, however.

IN PATH OF BIG SEAS

Steamer Admiral Borreson Nearly Swamped When Entering River.

Captain Winnes, master of the Norwegian steamer Admiral Borreson, which arrived here yesterday to load lumber for Shanghai, says that the immense wave his steamer encountered on her former voyage was an earthquake wave about a year ago was an earthquake wave without doubt.

It struck the steamer in the middle of the night when it was dark and everything above deck, including the deckload, was swept clean overboard. That the crew did not perish is due to the fact that the few men who happened to be on deck took to cover the moment they heard the monster wave approaching.

Coming here this trip from Victoria, B. C., the Admiral Borreson had a very rough trip, Captain Winnes saying that the steamer had to buck perfect hurricane all the way, with tremendous seas sweeping over the decks. Coming into the river the steamer shipped an immense wave that nearly submerged the whole hull.

DRIFTED AT RAPID RATE

Bottle Message Travels 1,500 Miles in Little Over Three Months.

John McNulty, nautical expert of the hydrographic branch at this port, has received a bottle message from the department in Washington that he figures traveled 1,500 miles.

The message was dropped from the French bark Anierles in April in 14 degrees 40 minutes north and 38 degrees 10 minutes west. It drifted mostly in the direction of the equator, and it is believed, in the equatorial current. The bark Anierles from which the bottle message was dropped is now at Portland to load.

WIRELESS FROM WATSON

Southbound Vessel Passes Two Lumber Laden Coasters.

The following wireless message was received by the Portland Heights wireless station during the night from the Puget Sound-San Francisco liner Watson.

"At 9 p. m., November 23, off Cape Mendocino, moderate sea. At 3:30 p. m., 36 miles south of St. George reef, passed lumber schooner with initial 'N' on smokestack, making good time with both sails set. At 4:30 p. m., 37 miles south of St. George reef, passed lumber schooner with initial 'W' on smokestack, main sail set and making good time."

BOATS FROM GRAYS HARBOR

Aberdeen Merchants Desirous to Reach Portland Market Promptly.

The establishment of a line of steamers between Grays Harbor and Portland is under consideration among the business men of Aberdeen as a result of the proposed discrimination of the Northern Pacific against Grays Harbor ports.

The Aberdeen Chamber of Commerce is expected to take the matter up at its next meeting, when a proposition to raise at least \$10,000 as a nucleus for the establishment of a line will be sprung. It is argued that a steamship line between Grays Harbor and Portland would prove a paying venture under any circumstances.

ALONG THE WATERFRONT.

The steamer Breakwater, Captain Macgregor, which arrives here last night from Coos Bay, left again tomorrow night. She had a stormy voyage going south, but encountered fair weather returning.

The Harriman liner Steamer, Captain Nopander, arrived here at an early hour this morning, bringing about 100 passengers from San Francisco. She had foggy weather in the beginning of the voyage and a strong breeze for the remainder of the trip.

The North Pacific Steamship company's steamer Geo. W. Elder is due to arrive here tomorrow morning from San Pedro and way ports.

The steamer schooner J. Marhofer cleared today for San Francisco, with 130,000 feet of lumber and several hundred tons of wheat on board. She will complete her deckload at one of the mills on the lower Columbia.

A concert will be given at the Portland Seamen's Friend society this evening, for the benefit of the fund for the relief of the sailors.

To prevent further clashes between the waiting factions of the longshoremen, plain clothes officers are stationed along the waterfront, Harbor Master Burnett believing an annoying possible disturbance in the bud.
