PRETTY JAPANESE WIFE COMES BACK TO MAN WHO SOLD HER

Kiki Obata, a Japanese, came to the United States some years ago. He got along well, as Japanese do, but he didn't always have all the money he wanted. Like other Japanese in this respect. Like other Japanese, Kiki began to borrow. To add to his troubles, two years ago he was joined by a dainty little maiden from the land of the mikado. They were married.
Kiki found himself in a worse predicament than before. Instead of saving money he found that his expenses—and his troubles—had been increased twofold. And he continued to borrow. The first thing Kiki knew he was in debt—heavily in debt, and his assets were but little.
One of Kiki's creditors was Ito Sakama, a Japanese of Portland. Kiki owed Ito something like \$400. Some months ago Ito asked Kiki to "come through"—he needed the money. Kiki said he couldn't pay the bill, even if he wanted to.
Ito, it seems, had seen Mrs. Kiki Obata, the cute little wife of Kiki. She was pretty and dainty and petite, as Japanese maidens go, and Ito liked her looks immensely. Again the two talked about the debt. Kiki said he couldn't pay. And along about this time Ito winked the other eye. And while winking he intimated that he was willing to take Mrs. Obata on the debt. Kiki meditated and finally decided.
One evening Mrs. Obata was transferred from the crowded quarters of Kiki to the more commodious and roomy apartments of Ito, the little brown man with the wink. Whether the Mrs. was consulted about the transfer has not yet come to light.
Ito and Kiki were contented and happy for a while, it seems. Then there was a change for the worse. Kiki became tired of her surroundings. She longed for Kiki and the crowded little quarters. So she thought and she planned and she schemed.
Last week Kiki complained to Mrs. Ito of the woman's police auxiliary, that she was being detained against her will. Mrs. Baldwin made an investigation and appealed to the United States authorities to take a hand in the matter. As a result Ito Sakama was arrested, charged with keeping, supporting and harboring an alien who has been in this country less than three years and contrary to the federal laws. Ito is in the county jail, a United States prisoner. This afternoon he is to have a hearing before a United States commissioner. His bail is \$5000.
So far there have been no takers.
Little Kiki has gone back to her crowded little rooms—home, and to her Kiki. The Obatas will be the principal witnesses for the government against the defendant, Ito Sakama, named in the complaint as John Doe Sakama.
Ito is much worried. He fears he may have to go to jail, and beside he will lose the \$400. Kiki was only with him a few months, he says. Kiki is worried, too, for fear even yet, after all that has happened, he may be made to pay the bill. Lawyers are funny, he says.
