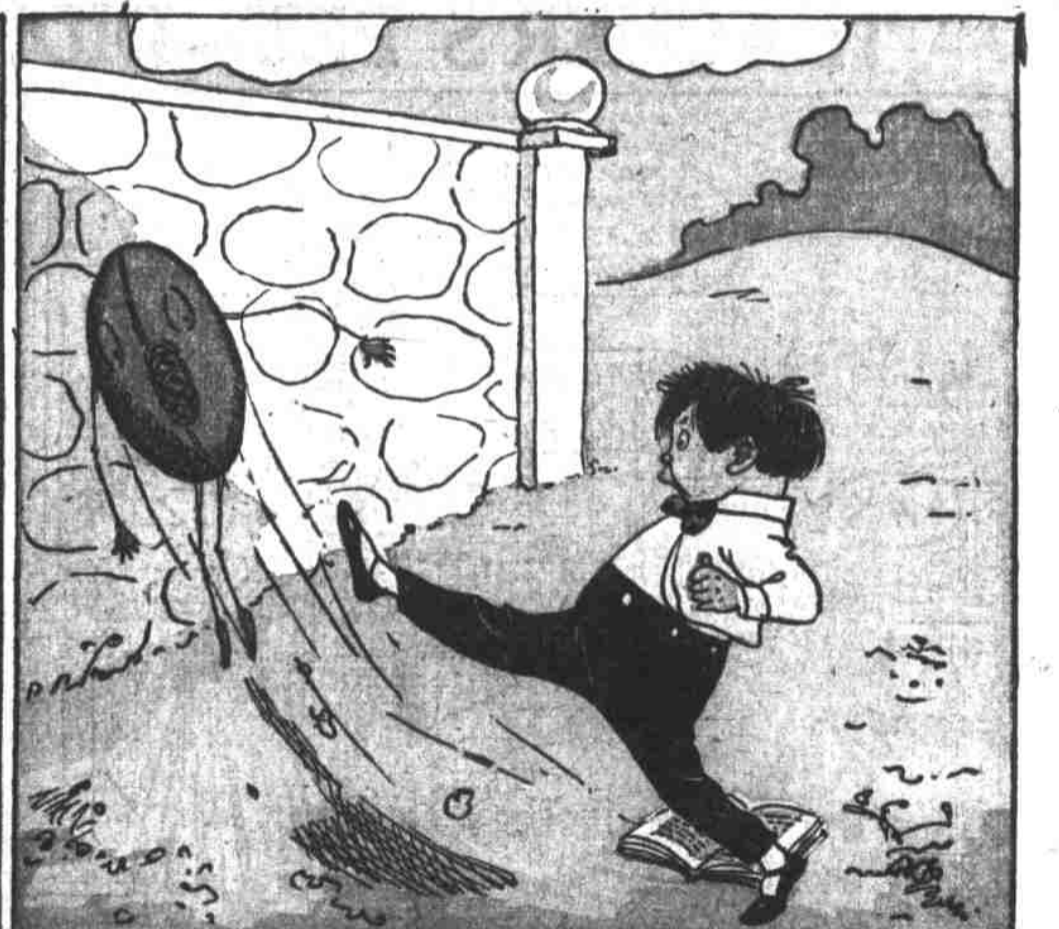
TED'S OBJECT LESSON--F-O-O-T-B-A-L-L AND N-O-S-E-G-U-A-R-D



"F-O-O-T-B-A-L-L--now that word I don't know. My lesson is so very hard, it makes me study so."



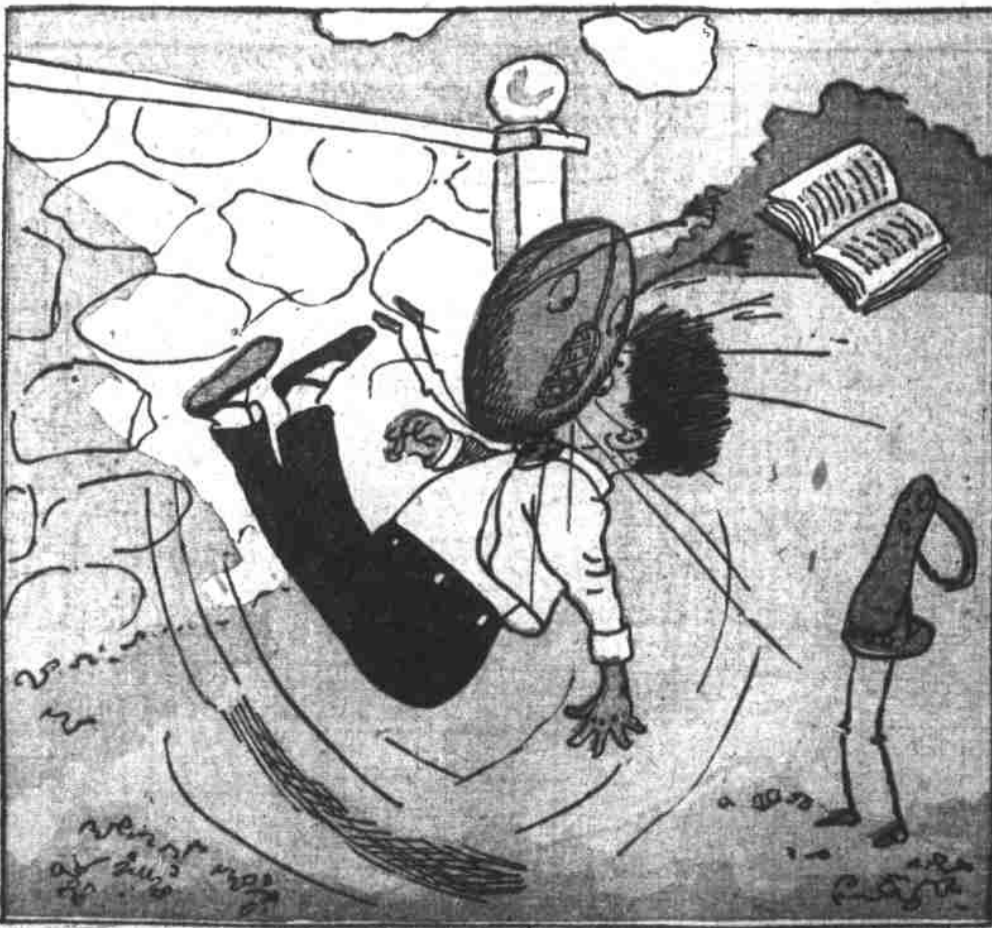
"Hello there, Ted, you know me now. Give me an awful kick. For I just love to bounce around; it never makes me sick."
