final factor in averting any possible restoration of the old political regime in the state.

The latest grange organization to raise the slogan of pure government is the well known Linn county council, Patrons of Husbandry. It is composed of delegates representing all the granges in Linn county, and its utterances are probably widely reflective of the sentiment among farmers throughout that county.

A feature of distinctive interest in the resolution is that the organization calls on all the granges to join in the defense of the commonwealth against the plan for restoration of the old political conditions in the state. The resolution, which was passed unanimously December 5, is as follows: "Whereas, The state grange at its last session set aside a liberal sum to procure competent legal assistance in defending our direct primary initiative and referendum laws which are jeopardized by the action taken by the Pacific States Telephone & Telegraph company in taking this matter up to the highest tribunals of the land with the avowed intention of destroying its workings, therefore be it

Resolved, by the Linn county council, P. of H., in regular session assembled, That we denounce in unqualified terms the actions of certain papers and persons who are aiding in the attempt to annul these laws and their workings by publishing and advocating their overthrow and we deplore and denounce these untimely, unwarranted and un-American methods to reinstate boss rule in our state politics. And we would urge the cooperation of granges throughout the state by publishing their resolutions in the public press.
