Colonel Dunne says he has not said that he intends to resign.

## SPECIAL SESSION ASKED IN IDAHO

(United Press Leased Wire.) Boise, Idaho, Dec. 10.—The judges of the Idaho supreme court today recommended to Governor Gooding that a special session of the legislature be called December 23, one week in advance of the regular session, for the purpose of considering the revised code of the Idaho statutes, ordered by the last legislature. The work of revision has been completed by a commission.

## LOOT BUNDLE CACHED IN GULCH

Two men, believed by Mrs. Kenney of 171 East Seventh street north, to be the highwaymen who robbed the East Side bank last Monday evening, were seen yesterday to enter Sullivan's gulch carrying bundles of packages and their arms, and later to emerge without the bundles, to be met by a third man with whom they went away.

## ACTION TAKEN ON "INSULT"

Washington, Dec. 10.—After several conferences the Republican leads of the house agreed this afternoon upon a line of action in dealing with President Roosevelt for his alleged insult to congress in his annual message.

"The trouble is," continued the captain, "that it is hard to get anything like an accurate description from any one who is not an expert at taking descriptions. Now, how old would you take me to be?"

There is a great deal of rivalry in this case among the various detectives working on the case. Nearly every private detective in town has been called by the police detectives, are searching for some clue that will lead to the arrest of the robbers. 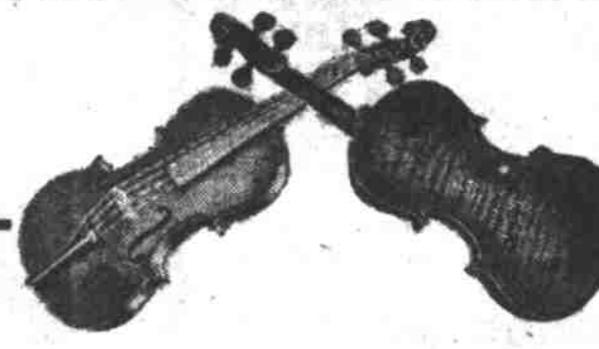
