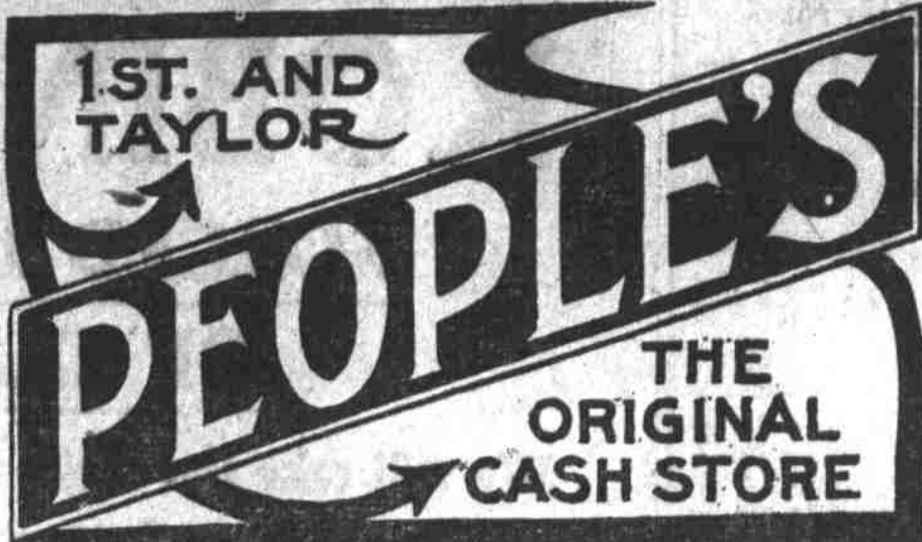

WATER FIGHT TAKEN UP TO WASHINGTON

(United Press Leased Wire.) Washington, Dec. 11.—There is serious trouble ahead for San Francisco before she perfects her claims to the Hetch Hetchy Valley water rights, according to a statement made by a high official of the interior department. This means that the monster \$45,000,000 undertaking is still far from the beginning of actual work. Congressmen Needham will demand that the city provide power to replace any lack of water that may be caused by dams above the Turlock and Modesto irrigation country. Representatives of the Spring Valley Water company are here also to make a fierce fight against the project, which would render their property worthless. They will claim that San Francisco's charter does not give it right to exchange lands with the government.
