### THREE KILLERS AT SAME JOB

(United Press Leased Wire.)  
 Vancouver, B. C., Dec. 16.—A triple hanging, an event almost unparalleled in the annals of justice in the Dominion of Canada, will take place at the provincial jail in New Westminster next Friday morning. Three convicted murderers, John Portella and Tom Jenkins, both negroes, and Lee Chun, a Chinese, will pay the penalty of their

crimes. All three were atrocious and cold-blooded murderers and although all the legal machinery possible has been invoked by the friends of the condemned men to avert the execution, the department of justice at Ottawa has decided not to interfere and will let the law take its course.  
 Dominion Executioner Radcliffe, the official hangman of Canada, left his home in St. Catharines last week and has arrived in New Westminster to prepare for his grim task. He intends to send all three men into eternity at once from a triple scaffold. The hour of the execution has been set for 8 o'clock in the morning.  
 This will be the second triple hanging in Canada. In the 60's the three McCain brothers were hanged in eastern Canada for the murder of a whole family during a drunken carousal. This will be the first time that Executioner

### FEAST OF VIRGIN OF GUADALUPE

Commemorating Vision of a Poor Indian, and Its Fulfillment.

 City of Mexico, Dec. 16.—For the 275th time the feast of the Virgin of Guadalupe, the greatest festival in the Mexican religious calendar, was celebrated in the capital today. Pious pilgrims to a total of nearly 50,000 came to the city from all parts of the republic to pay homage at the shrine in the famous church at the villa de Guadalupe, just outside the city. Since the passage of the reform laws, making the absolute separation of church and state in Mexico, the president and the government officials no longer take any part in the celebration, but its observance is none the less enthusiastic on the part of the populace.  
 According to tradition, it was in 1521, ten years after the conquest of Mexico by the Spaniards, that the Virgin Mary appeared to an Indian on the spot where the famous church now stands and commanded him to build an edifice to her honor on the site. This Indian was Juan Diego. It was on December 12 that he received his commission, which he proved to the bishop by showing him his blanket, on which had been miraculously imprinted an image of the Virgin.  
 This blanket, bearing the miraculous image, is still preserved in the church of Guadalupe. Money and costly jewels aggregating in value several millions of dollars have been given for

its adornment, and it now lies in a frame of solid gold, covered with a crystal plate, above the altar of the church which was erected by command of the Virgin. On each side of the image, within the golden frame, are strips of gold in which glitter and flash myriad diamonds, emeralds, pearls and other precious stones.
