BIG BOAT HELPLESS IN OUTGOING TIDE

(United Press Special Wire.) San Francisco, Dec. 18.—Laden with several hundred passengers and helpless in the grip of a powerful ebb tide, the Southern Pacific ferryboat Newark today narrowly escaped destruction on a treacherous shore of the Golden Gate.

The Newark was making her usual trip between this city and Oakland when an accident in the engine room led to the big boat at the mercy of the waves and wind. While the men of the engine room were endeavoring to repair a break in the paddle machinery, the craft began to race toward the straits. The passengers became alarmed and although the deckhands assured them there was no danger, the excitement was not allayed until the red stack, tugs Sea Queen and Sea Lion, responding to signals for assistance, made fast lines and took the ferryboat in tow.

The break in the engine room is serious and the vessel will be laid up for repairs until her engine room can be overhauled.
