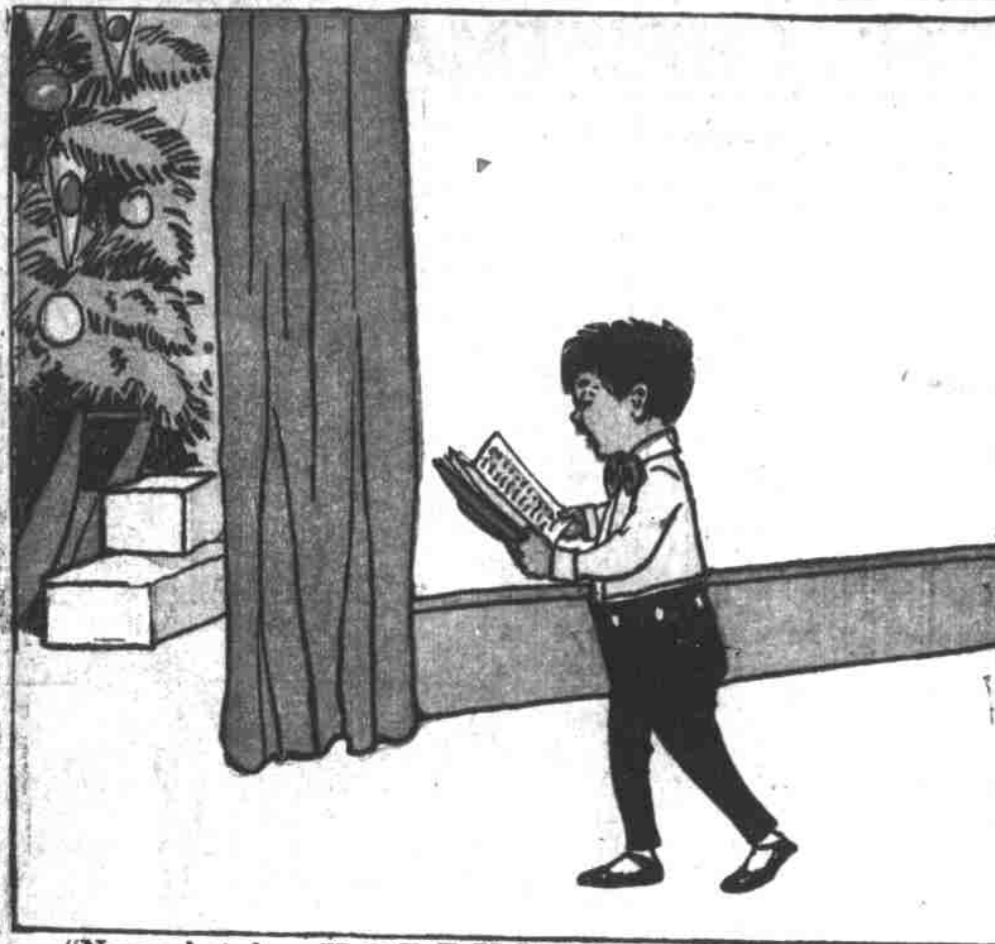

## TED'S OBJECT SPELLING LESSON---H-O-B-B-Y-H-O-R-S-E AND D-R-U-M



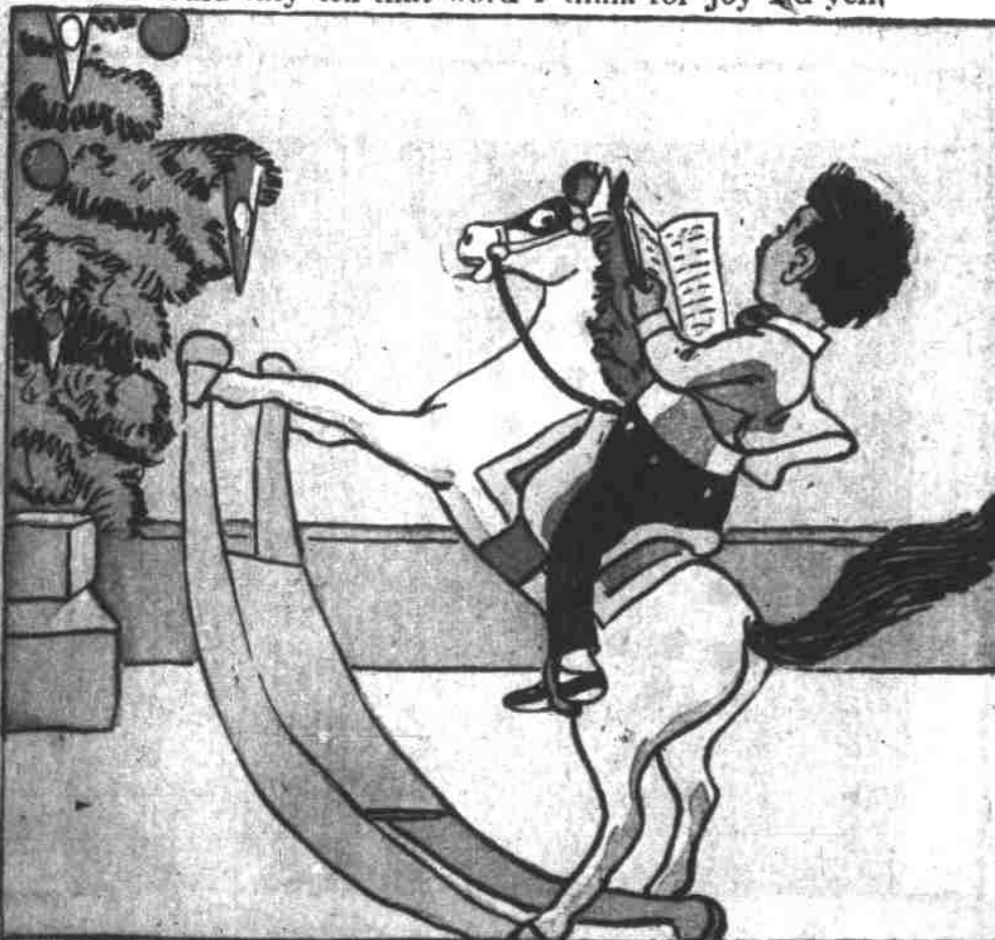
"Now what does H-O-B-B-Y-H-O-R-S-E spell?

Just jump astride and take a ride and see how I can fly."



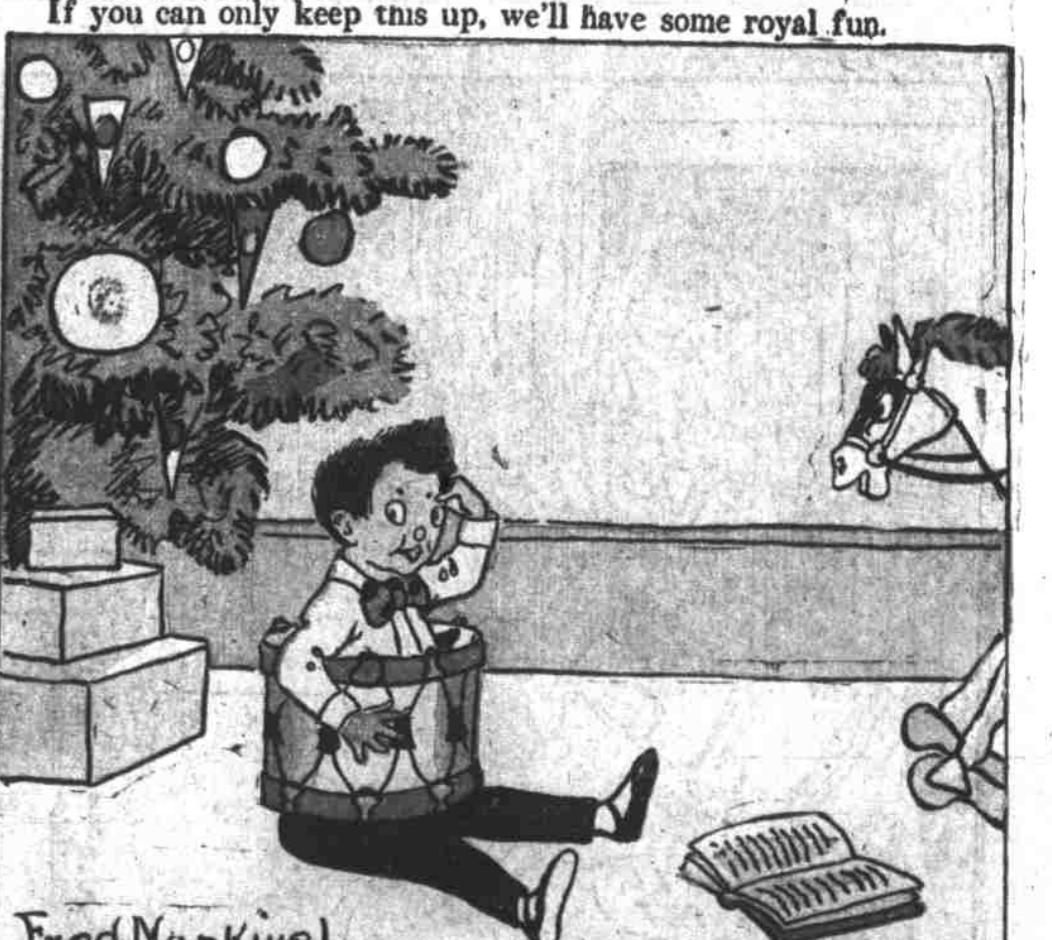
"Gid-ap there! Now, sir, don't be slow, let's see how you can run.
