WINDER CHARGE AGAINST WOMEN

Mrs. Erb and Mrs. Beisel to Be Tried for Killing Captain Erb.

Philadelphia, Dec. 19.—What promise to be one of the most notable criminal trials that has taken place in this section in a long time is scheduled to begin in Media next Monday, when Mrs. M. Florence Erb and her sister, Mrs. Catherine B. Beisel, will be tried for the alleged murder of Captain J. Clayton Erb, husband of the former.

EUGENE CIZES FOR ENJOINCTION

Seek to Enjoin Council From Prosecuting Work on Power Plant.

Eugene, Or., Dec. 19.—Following the rebuke administered to the council October 1 by the voters of Eugene in defeating the proposed \$500,000 bond issue with which to finance the proposed Ritchey creek municipal gravity system comes an injunction filed today against that body by representative citizens of Eugene, who seek to enjoin the council from proceeding with the project to construct a power plant on the McKenzie river and to restrain the defendants, Mayor J. Matlock and W. T. Campbell, R. M. Day, W. L. Chesire and P. D. Newell, from pretending to act as a board of water commissioners for the city of Eugene.
