

YEAR'S EXPORTS SHOW UP WELL

Portland Sends Away \$16,500,000 Worth of Commodities.

CALENDAR YEAR BEATS PREDECESSOR

Wheat Leads as Article of Export in Point of Volume - Flour Takes Second Place - Heavy Coastwise Shipments.

Exports for Year 1908. Wheat, 12,028,087 bu. Flour, 55,686,334 feet. Timber, 684,648 bbls.

Total for year \$16,555,203. Wheat, 951,519 bu. Lumber, 3,898,396 feet.

Portland's exports for the calendar year ending today exceed in value those of the calendar year 1907 by approximately \$1,500,000. This is considered an excellent showing.

The above figures furnish in abstract form the value of this section's sales of commodities raised and manufactured at home.

One of the lightest months of the year in point of exports is the month of January. The total value of the exports falling about 486,000 short of the \$1,000,000 mark.

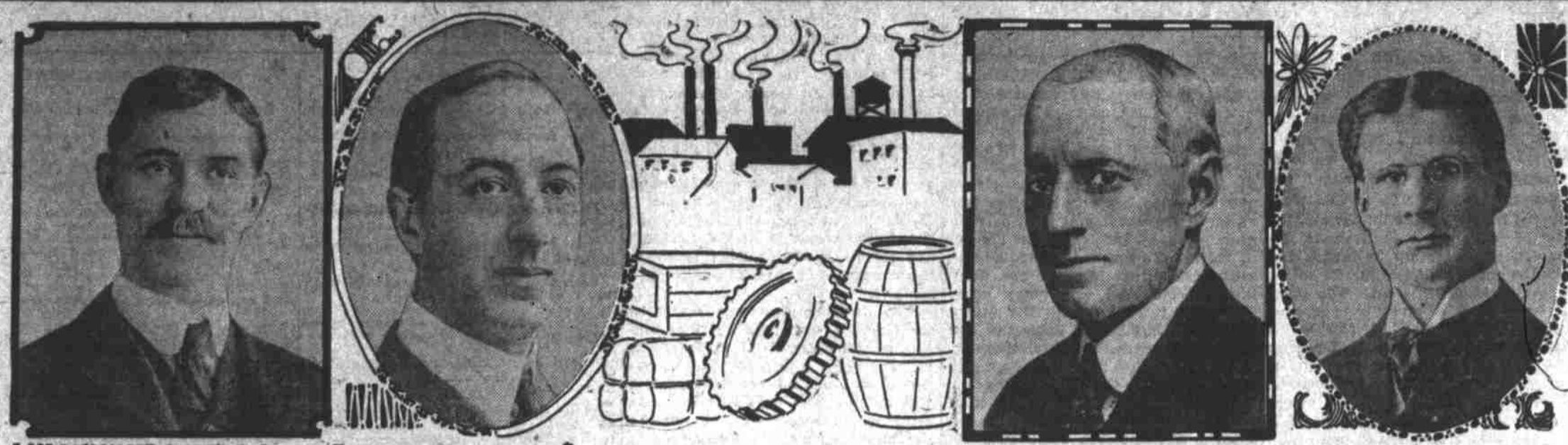
