

GROWERS OF EAST MULTNOMAH MEET

Matters of Import Will Be Discussed at Today's Gathering.

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.) Troutdale, Or., Jan. 5.—The Troutdale Fruitgrowers and Produce association, an organization of eastern Multnomah county farmers and fruitgrowers, will hold a meeting here this afternoon and evening.

The association, although only several months old, has already done much to better the condition of the farmers. It intends to take care of the production of all the foodstuffs of its members in this county. It is also the intention to develop the fruit producing lands; and to produce goods of such a high standard that they will command the highest market price.

From the present outlook more strawberries will be shipped from this point this year than ever before and the quality will be much better. It is generally believed that the land in this section of the county produces premier strawberries; that it will be but a short time until Troutdale will be as famous for its strawberries as neighboring territories are for their apples.

Troutdale potatoes have been commanding the highest price for many years, notwithstanding the fact that the production was double that of last year.
