American and Italian Flags Entertained at Bungalow Theatre.

The Italian royal standard and the stars and stripes, intertwined, last night graced the boxes of the Bungalow theatre, where the benefit entertainment for the Italian earthquake sufferers was given. Consul and Mrs. Candiani and their guests occupied the box, which was draped with the Italian colors.

The program was a mixed one, of selections by some of the leading singers of the city, vaudeville acts from various theatres and original acts by local entertainers, and there was a general feeling of good fellowship and appreciation which made all go smoothly. Programs and flowers were sold by young women, who assisted the committees of society women who arranged this feature.

Madame Norelli, fresh from her triumphs in England, was warmly received. She gave the air from Verdi's "Traviata," "Ah Fors e Lui," with all the dash and brilliancy that her temperament, training and power assure. After responding to an encore, as the applause still raged, she came back and sang "Home, Sweet Home," voicing the feeling of joy at being again at home and among friends.

Mrs. Rose Courzen Reed was at her best, and sang in her deep register, "My Garden of Roses," Felix, and a graceful ballad as encore. Her response and perfect control were never better manifested. Stuart McGuire sang "Thou Art Like Unto a Flower," the Rubinstein setting, showing his rich and mellow baritone to advantage. Don Zan had scope for his fine powers in "King Duncan's Daughters," which he gave with verve and dramatic feeling. His second number was "Drink to Me Only With Thine Eyes."

GIFTED FILIPINO VIOLINIST SWAYS ORPHEUM AUDIENCE

Sometimes the gallery whistles an accompaniment to a catchy song, but it is seldom that an entire theatre audience is literally taken off its feet by the playing of musical instruments. Yet that is just what happened at the Orpheum last night, when a violinist of rare power held the house from pit to dome in breathless attendance on the movements of his bow. The instrument fairly talked and the emotion it portrayed ran the gamut. Signor Travato, as he calls himself, is truly a virtuoso of the first water whatever a virtuoso may be. He had the house one minute rippling with smiles as a thousand pairs of feet marked time to some rollicking melody, and the next instant on the verge of tears as a sudden transition into something plaintively suggestive.

For encores, of which the Filipino received a half dozen, he played the old folk songs, the simple ballads and the national anthems of many nations. He has a delightful trick of ending a classical with a big rag time. It's really too bad, though, that the signor shakes his head so much, but that's probably a little eccentricity of the virtuoso.

Harvey sisters, tight wire dancers and the Kinsons are some of the other attractions that help complete one of the best bills yet given by the Orpheum.
