BRIDGE BONDS SOLD AT PREMIUM

Madison street bridge bonds to the amount of \$450,000 were sold yesterday afternoon to O'Connor & Kahler of New York. The premium offered by this firm was in excess of 2 per cent, and the largest ever paid for similar municipal securities.

The council also ordered the sale of \$250,000 worth of improvement bonds to the highest bidder. The ways and means committee last Monday afternoon would not agree, and the decision was left to the council. The bonds sold for a little better than par. Other bidders for the bridge bonds were the Harris Trust & Savings company of New York. This firm offered a premium of \$5000. N. W. Halsey made a bid offering \$2520 premium.

The city council this morning approved the sale of the Madison street bridge bonds to O'Connor & Kahler of New York, and a telegram to this effect was sent to the Gotham firm by City Treasurer Werlein.

BIDS ASKED ON STOCK EXCHANGE

Plans for Office Building Received by the Union Meat Company.

Plans for the new exchange building of the Portland Stockyards have been received at the local office of the Union Meat company from the Chicago architect of the company and bids for the construction of the building are now being submitted by Portland contractors. The building is to be a one story frame 60 by 120 feet and will rest on a concrete foundation. When completed it will cost between \$25,000 and \$30,000. The interior arrangement of the building will be admirably adapted to the purposes for which it is intended. The center will be a large lobby, where buyers and sellers may meet and discuss market conditions. Fifteen suites of offices will be provided for the occupancy of the commission men dealing in livestock. The business manager, president and secretary of the stockyards company will each have a private office. Separate offices for each of the telegraph companies, both local and long distance telephone booths and private offices for stock shippers will be provided. Provision has also been made for a barber shop and bathroom. Bids for the construction of the exchange will be closed this week and it is expected that work on the foundation will be under way within 10 days after the contract is awarded.

DAUGHTER LOSES IN ROBBERY PREVENTED BY FATHER'S DEATH

Bank at Amity Robbed Yesterday.
(Special Dispatch to The Journal.)
Amity, Or., Jan. 28.—A coincidence in connection with the robbery of the Amity bank here yesterday morning is that Mrs. Amanda Ferguson, who lost jewelry to the value of several hundred dollars is the daughter of J. Wright, whose death in all probability averted a wholesale bank robbery. Archie Massey and G. Kinnman were watching by Mr. Wright's bedside. When Mr. Wright passed away at 3:15 o'clock Massey went for the undertaker and encountered one of the robbers as he (Massey) passed the bank. Massey hurriedly gave the alarm. The safe-crackers had fled when he returned with assistance.

Mrs. Ferguson had a watch and some diamonds and other jewelry in one of the compartments of the vault, into which the robbers penetrated by wrecking the door. They secured her property and \$325 in stamps, and were on the point of blasting the door leading to the money box when they were frightened away.

PORTLAND PORT LOOKS A WINNER.
(By Journal Leases Salem Wire.)
Salem, Or., Jan. 28.—Port of Portland representatives made such a strong showing before the house committee on commerce last night that there is no doubt of a report in favor of giving Portland control over the Columbia bar pilots, with the power to abolish compulsory pilotage.

Portland's representatives argued that the compulsory pilotage was necessary to make the service self sustaining, and declared it was needed on Puget sound, instancing the deadly toll of the north coast.

To this C. F. Swigert and E. W. Wright, representing the Port of Portland, made effective reply. They said Portland had levied a tax to make up all deficiencies on pilotage and pilots need not fear they would be underpaid, since Portland would put them under proper discipline to cure present complaints and insure the quick handling of ships, either in or out of port.

As to Puget sound, the Portland men pointed out that it was the lack of compulsory pilotage there with which Portland must deal. This competition must be met, and the only way was to do away with just as much of the port charge as necessary. If river competition between Astoria and Portland on steam vessels needed to be removed to put that would be done.

Besides Swigert and Wright, Portland was represented by W. D. Wheelwright, John Driscoll and J. E. Wood. The Astoria argument was made by Representative McCue, Dan Welch and Captain W. Woods, the senior of the bar pilots.

From Woods' admissions were secured that pilots are better disciplined, and he said he would rather work under the Port of Portland than the present system. But he feared the pilots would be put out of business without compulsory pilotage, and he could see no necessity for paying the pilots from a public fund.

McCue argued that the main trouble was in the towage. If that were taken care of in the right way, he contended, the pilotage problem would be solved.

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CHUNG LOO AND WONG SAN LEAVE OWNERS OF NICOMEDIA IN LURCH.

Two Chinese belonging to the crew of the Portland & Astoria liner Nicomedia, escaped this morning and are being eagerly sought by the ship's officers and agents. The owners will have to dig up \$1000 for the two orientals unless they are produced in person before the liner departs.

The Chinese are named Chung Loo and Wong San. Chung Loo is a sailor with the unimpaired walk and Wong San is the cook's helper. How they got away is a mystery, but they succeeded in vanishing from sight although watchmen were guarding the steamer on every side.

BY BOAT TO TILLAMOOK

Passenger Accommodations Being Installed on the Argo.

The Portland-Tillamook liner Argo, Captain Jones, will be equipped to carry passengers when she starts out on her next trip from here. She arrived at Oak street dock this morning and a force of shipcarpenters were immediately put to work on the new accommodations for 20 passengers. The Argo will sail next Tuesday night.
