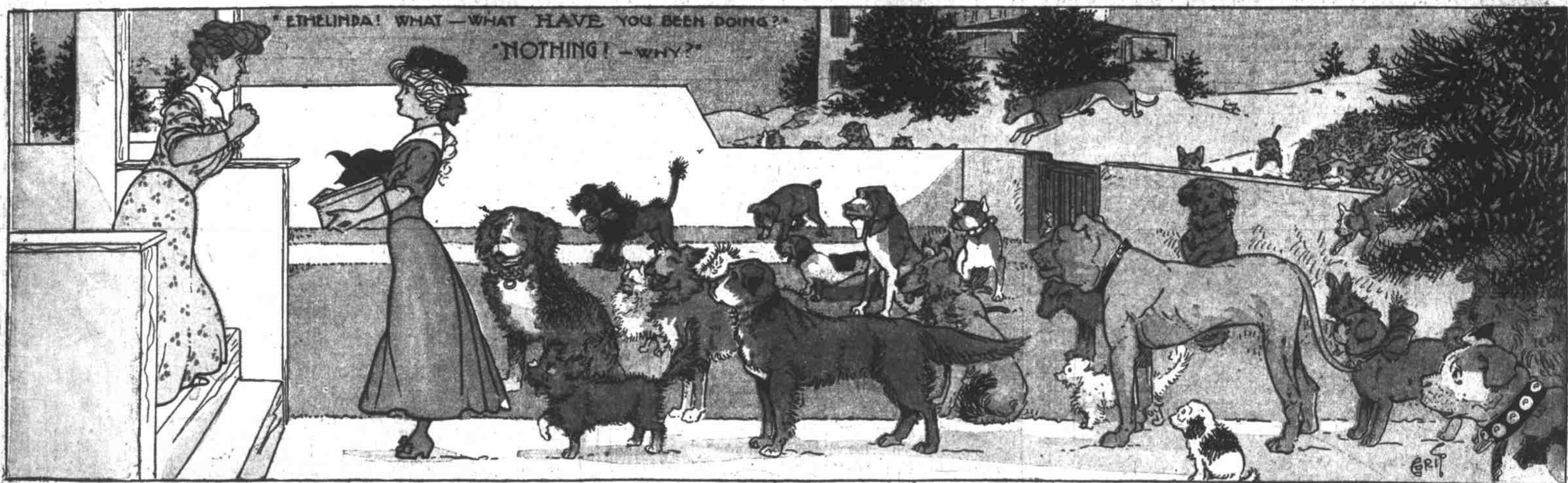


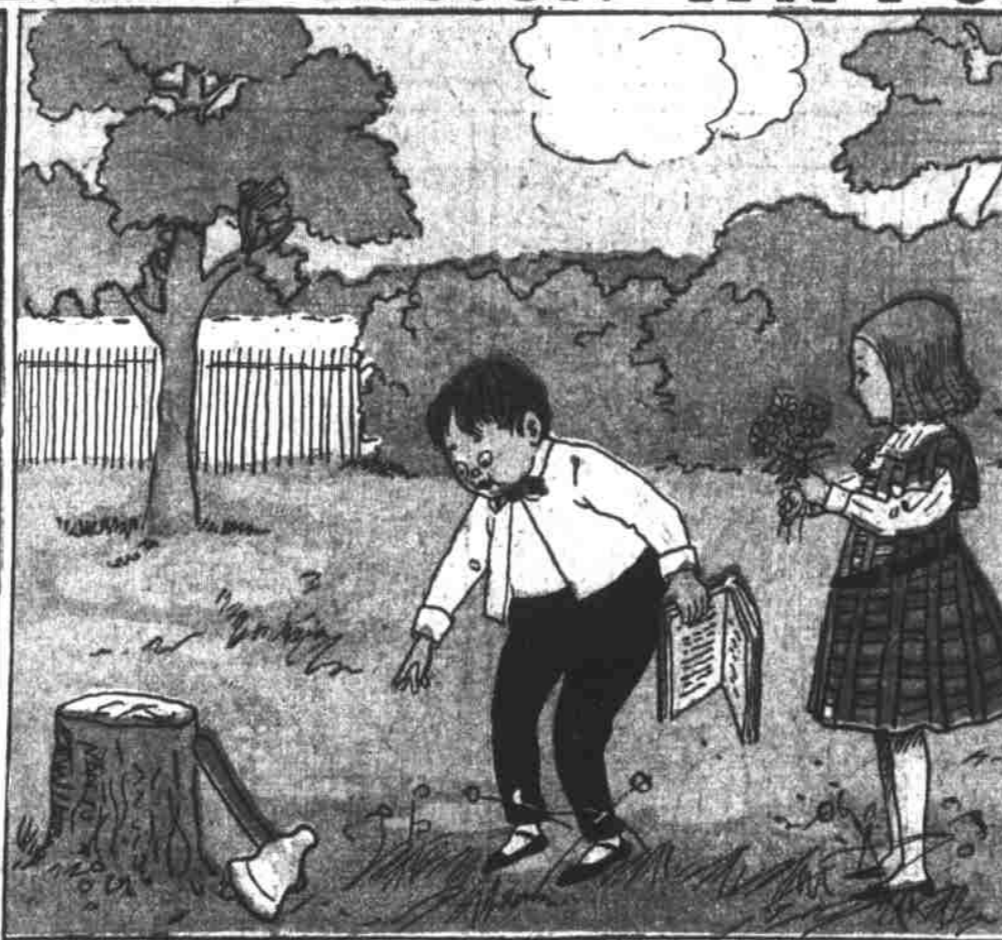

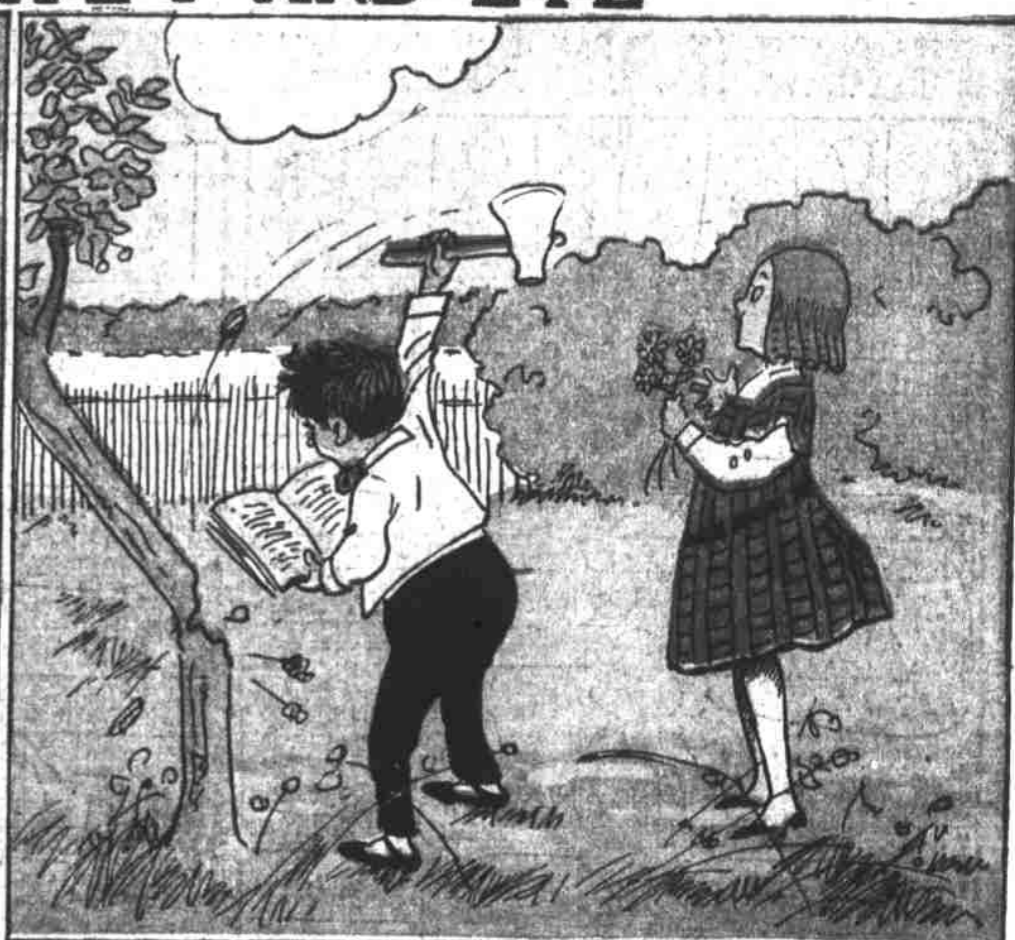
TED'S OBJECT SPELLING LESSON--H-A-T-C-H-E-T AND L-I-E
