THE LITTLE JOURNEYS OF NIP AND TUCK



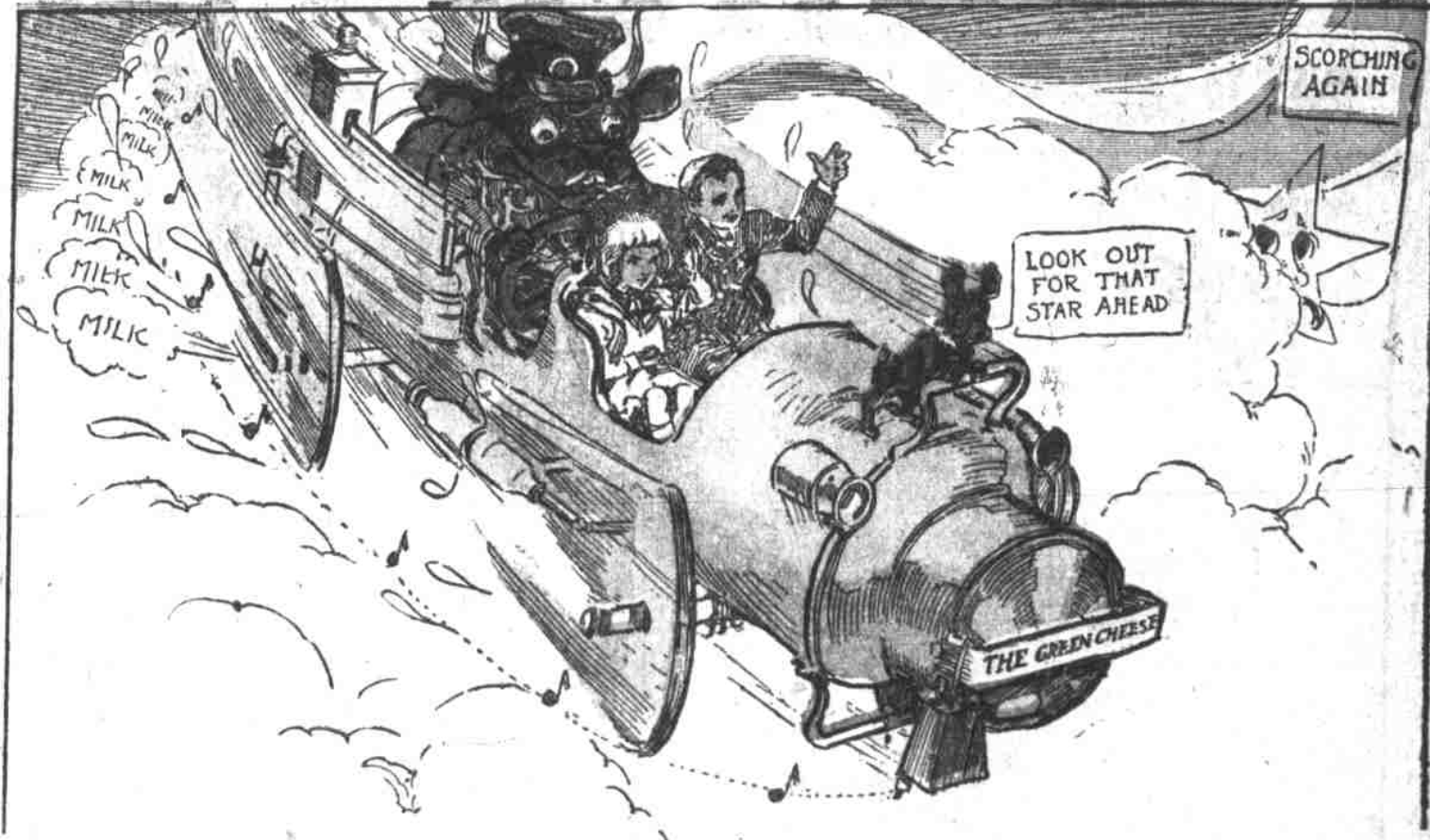
1. Nip and Tuck, who made the trip to Milky Way in magic ship,
