

# ANNA BATDORFF WINS HER CASE

## Supreme Court Decides Damages Must Be Paid—Other Decisions.

(By Journal Leased Salem Wire.)  
Salem, Or., April 6.—Through the charter of Oregon City expressly declares that the city will not be held liable for any casualty or accident happening to such person or property on account of the condition of any street or sidewalk, the supreme court today rendered a decision in the case of Anna Batdorff vs. Oregon City, in which a judgment against the city for \$500 awarded in a lower court on those very grounds is affirmed.

The decision is a triumph for Circuit Judge Thomas A. McBride, who heard the case. McBride had previously maintained that the legislature had no authority to grant such an exception to any city; that the constitution of this state as well as the organic provisions of the common law insured that "every man shall have remedy by law for injury done to his person, property or reputation."

Supreme Court Reverses.  
The supreme court in its decision today reversed itself, for in O'Hara vs. Portland, and many subsequent cases, it was held that a clause in a city charter exempting it from liability for damages received on account of injuries sustained because of neglected sidewalks, was void. It is always maintained that the Oregon supreme court was wrong and evidently has convinced the court of the justice of its position.

It is also held in this case that the city and not the councilmen are held liable for damages received on account of neglected sidewalks. The opinion was written by Chief Justice Moore, and is signed by Chief Justice Moore, J. H. Bennett and F. Humphrey, a suit to quiet title appealed from the circuit court for Cook county, J. W. Hamilton, Judge, is affirmed in an opinion written by Justice King.

Last night began the celebration of the Feast of the Passover, one of the most important of Hebrew festivals. It is observed in commemoration of the time when the Lord passed over the houses of Israel and the first born of the Egyptians only were slain. At that time the Feast of the Passover was decreed with all the rites that must be observed, and it has been faithfully observed with special ceremonies since that time. At sunset last night all leavened bread was removed from the Jewish homes with proper ceremony, and unleavened bread only will be eaten for seven days.

Last night services began at Temple Beth Israel at 6 o'clock, this morning at 10 o'clock Dr. Wise preached on "The Passover Sacrifice." A Havdalah synagogue held services last night and this morning, and will hold them this evening and tomorrow morning.

Rev. R. Abrahamson is conducting the services there. At the Talmud Torah synagogue services are being held today and tomorrow, as also the First Street synagogue.

# WEATHER FORECAST

The Arizona and northwestern low pressure areas have united and formed a single disturbance of decided character which is central this morning near Kansas City. The barometer is rising rapidly in the north Pacific and northern Rocky mountain states, and the pressure is relatively high over the Atlantic and east Gulf states. During the last 24 hours light showers have occurred in the north Pacific states and moderate heavy rains have fallen in the middle Mississippi and lower Missouri valleys. Heavy snow has fallen in Colorado and light snow has fallen in northern Arizona, northern New Mexico, western Nebraska and in the western portion of the Dakotas. The temperatures are slightly below normal on the Pacific coast and decidedly below normal in the northern Rocky mountain states. Between the Mississippi river and Atlantic coast it is unseasonably warm, with the temperatures in many parts of that section 10 or more degrees above normal. The indications are for generally fair weather in this district tonight and Wednesday, with light frost tonight in western Oregon and western Washington and with light to heavy frosts in the eastern portion of these states and in Idaho.
