TED'S OBJECT SPELLING LESSON--B-E-E-S AND H-O-N-E-Y

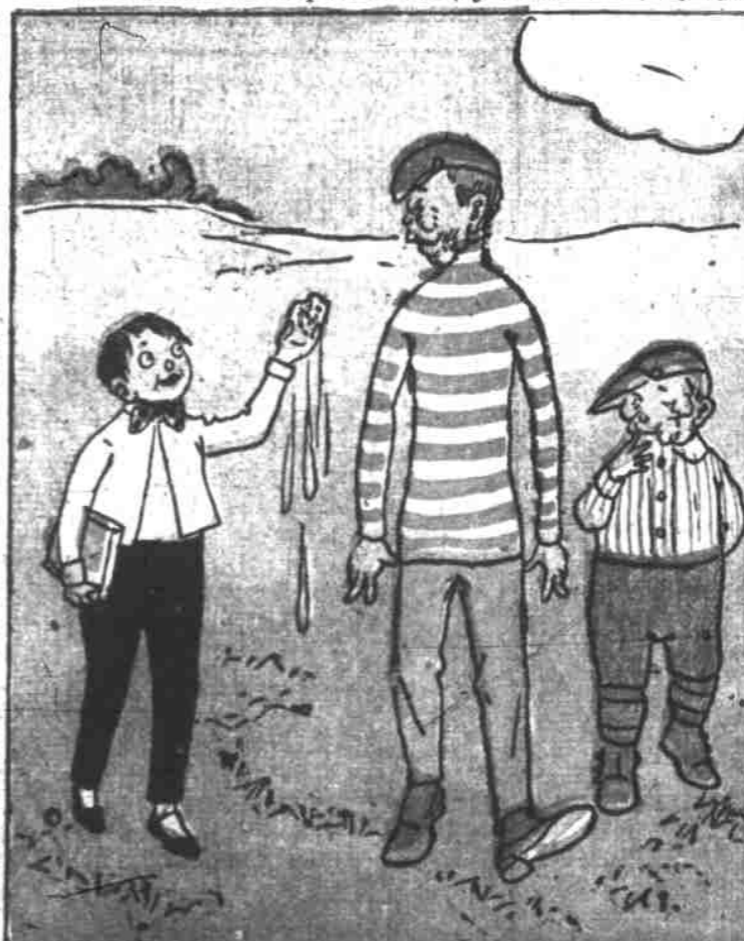


"B-E-E-S, what does that spell? Say, can't you please spell me?"
