CUPS GIVEN OUT
TOMORROW NIGHT
**Judges Take Brief Rest in
Passing on Entries at
the Dog Show.**

Major Taylor and John Bradshaw, the judges at the dog show, today took a well earned rest after having judged nearly 200 dogs in less than two days, and not until tonight, when the special judging yesterday was declared, will their work be resumed again. Tomorrow evening, the last of the show, the cups for the best dogs in the show will be distributed.

Champion Edgewood Biddle, winner of many ribbons and trophies at other shows, was again a winner, when at the judging yesterday she was declared the best bull terrier in the show, while her pup, Sound End Challenger by Williamette Peer, was declared the next best and the best of opposite sex. Biddle, 8 years old as she is, is still showing as well as many dogs several years her junior. She has scored 87 wins here and possesses 116 championship points, whereas but 10 are required for qualification.

She was brought over to this country from England after having captured four championships there, and since then has captured 87 first places. She

is owned by G. C. Israel of Tacoma. Only last week she captured the same honors at the Tacoma show.
