

ORIENTAL LINER GOES TO CHINA

Steamship Alesia Sails With Lumber and Flour for Far East.

COOS BAY STEAMER HAS SMOOTH TRIP

Alliance Brings Lumber for Shipment to Wisconsin—New Traffic Arrangement Will Give Through Service From Eastern Points.

Taking a little over a thousand tons of Oregon lumber and flour, the Captain Ernest will sail today for Yokohama and Hongkong.

For the last four or five years the annual line has been run for a fleet of four German steamers, the Alesia, Arctida, Nantania and the Sella.

Occasionally there would be trips nearer the summer months, but on one of these, while off Port Arthur, and on the way to Tokyo, the Lydia was wrecked by a storm.

With passengers and freight from Coos Bay, the steamer Alliance, Captain Parsons, arrived this morning.

This is the first large shipment to an eastern mill for some time, but manufacturing interests in the states which formerly export lumber are being more profitable to use Oregon lumber.

After June 15, the Alliance will enter a traffic arrangement with the next few days.
