STATE OFFICES UNDER SUSPICION

Washington Investigating Committee Recommends Further Examination.

Atlanta, Ga., June 24.—Results important and far reaching in their character are expected to follow the conference of farmers and planters which began in this city today under the auspices of the Farmers' union, an organization which has added 1,000,000 members to its roster within less than a decade.

The marketing of cotton and wheat crops is the chief topic to be discussed by the conference, the sessions of which will last four or five days. For several years the Farmers' union has been actively engaged in bringing about a closer cooperation among cotton planters for their mutual benefit. The elimination of the middlemen and the prevention of cotton exchange speculation have been the objects sought. Recently the same movement has been extended to the wheat farmers and with the same end in view.

FARMERS' UNION HOLDS CONFERENCE

Philadelphia, June 24.—Charged with the murder of John Bradley D. Skidmore, the original of the hero of Owen Wister's "Virginian," is on trial here. Skidmore was formerly a cowboy and plainsman and until recently was a member of the Philadelphia police force.

He is alleged to have shot and killed Bradley in this city, November 21. Bradley had just returned from an extended visit in San Bernardino, Cal.

German Sunday School Convention.
Cincinnati, Ohio, June 24.—The national Sunday school convention of the German M. E. church began in this city today with delegates in attendance from nearly all parts of the country. The speakers to be heard during the three days' session include Bishop Nelson of Ohio, Dr. David Dwyer of Chicago, Dr. Joseph Clark, state secretary of the International Sunday School association, and Professor F. W. Schneider of Nashville, Tenn.

FATTED CALF FOR MR. PELL

Not a Prodigal Son, but Once There Was Prodigal Ancestor.

New Rochelle, N. Y., June 24.—A unique and amusing ceremony was witnessed today by a large crowd of New Rochelle citizens gathered at the Bronx Manor house, which is the residence of George H. Pell. The event of the day, and the occasion for the ceremonies and festivities, was the presentation of a fatted calf to Mr. Pell on behalf of the city of New Rochelle. Mr. Pell received the gift with dignified courtesy befitting a direct descendant of Lord Pell, who was the original owner of New Rochelle, and thanked the mayor and other city officials who made the presentation.

The presentation of the fatted calf to Mr. Pell marked the revival of an old custom. When Lord Pell sold the 6000 acres now comprising the city of New Rochelle to the Huguenots in 1688 for about \$800, he thought he had made such a good deal that he threw in another 100 acres for a church, on condition that the Huguenots would every year thereafter present to him or his heirs or assigns a fatted calf. The Huguenots kept their word for many years, but finally allowed the custom to lapse. Recently at the unveiling of a Huguenot monument Mr. Pell met the mayor of New Rochelle and jokingly reminded him that the fatted calf had not been given for many years, and that this year he would make a demand on the city for the calf. The mayor laid the matter before the board of aldermen, who promptly decided to buy a calf and present it to Mr. Pell with appropriate ceremonies.
